WELCOME



Welcome each member and make time to find out how it's going with each one. Give them some time to share their experiences and how they enjoyed their break.

WORSHIP



Sing 2x praise and 2x worship songs and spend some time praying focused in tongues during the last worship song for people that are lost or who you still want to invite to church.

WORD



One Thing I Do.

Read: Phil. 3:13

- You might not be where you want to be but thank God you're not where you used to be.
- We must have a vision in our life to end up where we should be.
- If you do not have a vision for your life you must find one and if you do have a vision it is important to revisit your vision on a regular basis.

Ask yourself: Do you have a vision or one thing you have committed your life to?

- Paul only spoke about one thing – to preach the gospel of grace to the world
- From this one thing many responsibilities, tasks and challenges will come, but we must keep our focus only on the one thing.

Read: James 1:8b

- A double minded man is unstable in his ways
- Stick to one thing – to win the lost at any cost
- Our responsibility is that each one must reach one
- First seek His world (His Kingdom) before you seek your world
- All other ministry then flows from that understanding
 - We reach out the poor to 1st win the poor then to see to the needs of the poor.
 - We reach out to the prisoner to 1st win the prisoner then to minister to the prisoner.
 - We reach out to the students or businessmen or sick in hospital or destitute to 1st win them to Jesus then all ministry flows from there.

Read: 1 Cor. 9:19-23

Ask yourself: As a member of CRC are you still focused and committed to our One Thing 1st? Or has something else distracted you or diverted your focus?

- You have to make yourself a servant to everybody to win them.
- It cannot be all about you – you have to become all things to everybody
- The church will grow if you do your one thing
- We spent more time trying to avoid sin ourselves instead of focusing on our one thing in taking the gospel to sinners so they can avoid eternity without God.

Read: Phil. 3:7-9

- The more you are under the law the more self-righteous you become.
- You will not get to Jesus through your good works
- He wants your heart first
- Take the light to the world

Read Rom3:21

- We are made right by placing our faith in Jesus Christ
- All have sinned
- You are free – you should not be under the law
- God's grace make us right
- We must not forget what Jesus had done for us

Read: Gal. 1:6-10

- Preach the Gospel
- Do not listen to people who preach anything else but the Gospel
- It's not you anymore but Christ in you.....the hope of glory.

Ask yourself: Have you grasped the meaning of your Spiritual vision of salvation, the reason for Jesus coming to the earth, the reason for His betrayal, His Death, His Resurrection, His Assent ion, the sending of the Holy Spirit and the power available to you the believer. Have you grasped the meaning of; understand, perceive all that in order to live a victorious life?
