Ps Aidan – Count on me

WELCOME

Welcome each member and make time to find out how it's going with each one and what they've been up to during the holidays. Give them some time to share what is happening and if there are some good testimonies.

WORSHIP

Sing 2x praise and 2x worship songs and spend some time praying in tongues during the last worship song and focus on people that are lost or who you still want to invite to church.

WORD

Read: 1 Cor. 4:1

Paul says that he is committed to Christ for life

- Can God count on you?
- It is reassuring to know that our God can be counted on
- He will never leave or forsake us
- We have to be the next generation to build His Kingdom

Read: Hebr. 13: 5b-6

Many of the exchanges and conversations between Jesus and His disciples were built around this subject - Can I count on you.....Disciples?

Read: Matt. 26:33-35

- The disciples said that Jesus could count on them
- Peter did not – but because of God's grace, that after He had risen from the dead Peter was the 1st person He looked for "You can count on me Lord"
- He calls us to a place of commitment

Read: 2 Tim. 2:13 and Luke 19:40

- God will make the stones talk about Him if we don't
- Do not allow the rock to be more committed than you
- The enemy will neutralize you
- The enemy will make you afraid to try and make you to stop
- The devil is the father of all lies

Ask yourself: Can you still be counted on?

- I am account – able
- I will show up
- I am committed
- I will use the gifting that God gave me and know that He will give me favour and blessings

Rick Warren said "Nothing shapes your life more than the commitments you choose to make."

Vince Lombardi said "Individual commitment to a group effort - that is what makes a team work, a company work, a society work, a civilization work"

Anonymous "Commitment means staying loyal to what you said you were going to do, long after the mood you said it in has left you."

Accountability is simply my ability to be counted on, I am accountable

Read: 1 Cor. 4:1

- You are a minister – "Huperetas" for Christ.
- Servant
- Rower – to be an UnderOarsman
- Jesus was so committed He got nailed to the cross

Ask yourself: are you still chained to the seat of your commitment to Chris and His Kingdom?

Read: Luke 18:8b

- Will He find commitment to faith?
- The enemy is a trophy hunter
- He wants you to miss the people that can be saved for the kingdom

Read: 1 Pet. 5:8-9

- Be vigilant
- We don't for one moment fear the enemy or give him any glory but he will relentlessly attempt to get into your mind with all sorts of allegations
- Never confuse the voice of the enemy telling you to jump ship, which is often fed by offense and self-justification and self-righteousness in order to destroy your destiny **versus** the voice of the Lord telling you to get out of the boat and walk on water, which is fed by faith, faithfulness, peace and unity in order to advance and increase your destiny.

Read 2 Cor. 11:23-30

Paul says....I can go on and on about my outer sufferings and struggles and even compare mine to someone else's and even come up with so many reasons to quit but, I don't do this for my glory, I count it an honour to labour for my Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ....

Read Phil. 3:7-11 and 2 Tim. 1:6-7

To be counted on is not a onetime event and that's it for life!! No to be counted on is a daily check on self to validate am I still accounted for!! Am I still producing at the level of my original commitment?

Read: Rom. 12:1

- Your body has to be your living sacrifice
- God can only use you at the level of your sacrifice

- God wants to have a relationship with you
- God wanted to know if He could count on Abraham so He tested him with Isaac
- Ultimately He sent His Son to show His commitment to us

Read: 1 Pet. 1:6-7

5 BIG C's to Commitment and Accountability.

- Commit to Christ.
- Commit to a church.
- Commit to the commission
- Commit to community.
- Commit my career.

Commitment Declaration:
