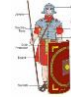

WELCOME 

Welcome each member and make time to find out how it's going with each one. Give them some time to share what is happening and if there are some good testimonies.

WORSHIP 

Sing 2x praise and 2x worship songs and spend some time praying in tongues during the last worship song and focus on people that are lost or who you still want to invite to church.

WORD 

Fully armed and dangerous

Read: Matt. 16:13-19 (Text vs. 18-19)

Ask yourself – what kind of church is Jesus talking about

- A victorious conquering church
- Not a church hiding away in a cellar with canned food waiting for the rapture bus!
- He is talking about the church that will engage and take over – not a church that will roll over!

He is talking about:

- A church of power
- A church of dominion
- A church on the offensive
- For too long the church has been on the defensive – no more as it is time for the church to go on the offensive
- To take back what the devil stole
- To plunder hell and populate heaven

Daniel prophesies about this Kingdom that will take over everywhere

Read: Dan. 2:44 and 7:27

- God is building His church in the midst of all this turmoil in our world
- Revival is sweeping the nations because God promised

Read: Hab. 2:14 and Is. 9:6-7

- God is building His church and the gates of hell shall not prevail
- It is our time – time for believers in this nation to stand up everywhere and to silence the enemy and to push back the tide of evil.

Read: Is. 59:19b

- It is time to destroy the works of the evil one preaching the gospel everywhere with fire and passion

Read: 1 John 3:8

Too often:

- we sit on the sideline and allow the works of the devil to manifest in our lives and in our world
 - we tolerate and allow what we don't have to in our personal lives, in society and in our world
 - we face prolonged battles because we do not exercise our authority over the devil
-
- God means for us to overcome any and every form of evil against us

Read: 1 John 5:4

- God promises us the victory in and before every battle

Read: Rom. 8:37, 2 Cor. 2:14 and 1 Cor. 15:57

- Every battle we face has its origin in the spirit world
- Although we do not live devil or demon conscious – we have to deal with him when we see his works manifesting

Read 2 Cor. 2:11, Eph. 4:27 and 1 Pet. 5:8-9

- We are not called to defeat the devil for he is already defeated
- We are called to enforce his defeat
- We need to be fully armed

So what does it mean to be fully armed?

- You must know your authority as a believer
- You must know your power as a believer
- You must know how to exercise and release your power and authority as a believer

Read: Matt. 16-18-1, Matt. 18:19 and Luke 10:17-20

Keys represent authority

- To open or close
- To bind or to loose
- We have the authority in Jesus Name!

Understand 4 things

1. Jesus has all authority and power in heaven and earth – not the devil
 - When people see the devil one day, their response will be "is this the one"
 - He only has power, because of deception
 - He can only operate the earth because people yield to his lies and deceptions
 - Jesus has all authority because He defeated Satan and took from him the keys of hell and death

Read: Col.2:15

- At the cross Jesus defeated the devil and all his demons once and for all
- At the cross Jesus publicly stripped them of all their authority and power
- Jesus defeated the devil and made a show of him publicly

Read: Rev. 1:17-18, Matt. 28:8 and 1 Cor. 2:8

2. Jesus has delegated this authority to His church – you and me
 - He gave us the keys of the Kingdom of Heaven
 - Whatever we bind on earth is bound in heaven
 - Whatever we loose on earth is loosed in heaven
 - Nothing will change in the Spirit world and therefore in this natural world until we bind and loose

Read: Matt. 28: 18-20

- Word authority means
 - Power of attorney
 - Delegated authority to act on behalf of another
 - To act in someone else's stead as if they are acting themselves
 - You have been given the same authority Jesus Has
 - We have heaven, angels, saints backing us up when we act on God's behalf
3. Your authority and dominion is connected to your relationship with God through Jesus
 - Outside or apart from Jesus you have no authority over the devil's power

Read: Acts 19:13-17

- For us to experience God's authority work through us, we have to live submitted to and dependent on Him
- We have to allow His authority to flow through us

Read: James 4:7-8 and John 15:4-5

- Putting on the armor of God is nothing more than living saturated in the presence of Jesus – allowing Jesus to live in you and through you

Read: Rom 13:14

4. You must know your authority through Jesus name

- God gave the name of Jesus to His church

Read: Phil. 2:9-11

- The name of Jesus is exalted above every other name
- The name of Jesus is like no other

Read: Acts. 4:12

- His name is your access card into heaven's riches

Read: John 14:13-14 and John 16:23

- His name gives you authority and release it in Jesus name
- Jesus in you is bigger and more powerful than
 - All the devils out there
 - Any sickness or disease
 - Any mountain or storm
