WELCOME

WORD

Then Jesus came

Read: John 20:19-20 – Jesus came

- Disciples had no doubt that Jesus had died – He died of a broken heart
- His return was very mysterious
- They locked themselves away in fear – then Jesus came

When?

- He came when all sin has been atoned, therefore when Jesus came your sin was gone – He died for your sin
- Heb. 9 – no remittance for sin. In the Old Testament sin was never removed, but when Jesus came it was done
- He washed your sin away – Only one sacrifice when Jesus died for our sin
- You have Calvary but also Resurrection Sunday. The resurrection guaranteed that the atonement was done
- If you are in Chris you are accepted
- You have life – you do not have to fear death

How?

- He did not come as a ghost but in body form – a glorified body
- An immortal body – not a corruptible body
- He came mysteriously – the doors were closed – locked

- We have to accept this by faith
- You ask Jesus into your life and He also comes in
- He stands in the midst – His rightful place
- Jesus has to be the centre of your life. Is He?

Why?

He came to bestow three gifts

1. Gift of pardon – forgiveness.
All sins have been taken care off.
You need to forgive yourself otherwise He has died in vain.
2. He gave His peace.
The peace of God has to flood your life.
You have peace with God through Jesus Christ.
3. He came to give them power
Receive the Holy Spirit
Go and preach the Gospel to the entire world
Do not go without the Power of the Holy Spirit
Have you experienced the Pentecost in your life – revival must start and be in your life everyday
