WORD

I can, I will, I must

God is raising up a generation unashamed of their faith in Jesus who will say, we can, we will, we must

- **Read:** Phil. 4:13 it is one of the greatest "I can" statements made by Paul
- The reason why we still preach about Paul's life 2000 years later is because he lived a "can do" life
- To live a "can do" life is a choice
- When Paul heard that some of the Christians wanted to quit, he writes to them to tell them that they have a choice. They have a choice to have a "can do" attitude in the midst of the challenges they are facing. He reminded them that we are all going through challenges in different ways.

Read: 2 Cor. 11:23-28 NLT

- Our battles are not the same as Paul's, but all of us is going through and facing some battles
- Despite the challenges that Paul was facing, he chooses to say "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me".

There are "I can do" people and "I cannot do" people

1. Can do people are the people that change the world

Read: Is. 6:8 AMPC

While can't do people choose to be changed by the world

2. Can do people see their glass as half full

Read: 1 Sam. 17:49 AMPC

Israel army said, have you seen the size of Goliath and David said, yes that is why it's impossible to miss him

While can't do people see their glass half empty

3. Can do people have an "I am a victor" mindset. If God be for me, who can be against me

Read: Rom. 8:31, 38-39 AMPC

While can't people have an "I am a victim" mindset. Why is God and everyone against me?

4. Can do people face challenges not problems. Challenges are problems they are busy solving by faith

Read: John 11:14, 41-44

While can't people are only facing problems. They are too afraid to challenge. Only when we die we will be free from challenges.

5. Can do people have a “Who and how can I serve someone or somewhere attitude”
Read: Acts 9:6 AMPC
 While can't do people ask, why is no one serving me? Do you who I am?
 Judas had to kiss Jesus before betraying Him, because he was unrecognizable. He looked like everyone around Him. He was busy serving His generation

6. Can do people, live with a generous seed minded attitude looking who they can bless. Where they can give to make a difference and whose life they can change through generosity.
Read: Prov. 11:25 NLT
 While can't do people live with a poverty need minded attitude looking for people to bless them. Asking why no one is making a difference in their life. Who can change their life through generosity?

7. Can do people see opportunities in every situation because their faith is in God and not in man
 Joshua and Caleb possessed their promised land, and overcame the Giants because they were “can do” people. They saw the opportunities in their future in the midst of their Giants
Read: Num. 13:30-33 NKJV
 While 10 other leaders, those that never possessed, never entered their promised land were “Can't people”

8. Can do people energize your day, they energize the meeting, and they energize the possibilities toward the solution. While can't do people drain your energy, drain the meeting and such the life out of your day. It takes darkness to develop a negative.
Read: Matt. 5:14-16

9. Can do people speak words of life and not death. Can do people understand the importance of words
Read: Prov. 6:2 NKJV, Matt. 12:33-37

10. Jesus understood that to be a success as a “can do” person, can only happen through and with other people
Read: John 5:30 NKJV
 Paul said that he can do all things through Christ – not by himself
 Jesus says I can do yes, but I cannot do it by myself
 Jesus needed His Father, he often was alone with His Father but He was not a lone ranger
 Jesus needed 12 disciples, needed the sick to be a Healer, and He needed the lost to be a Saviour
 Jesus of Himself and by Himself, could do nothing
 If Jesus by Himself could not do things of Himself, how must more you and I
 If we work together as a team we can achieve more
 Jesus said, where two or three are gathered, I am with you
 When Adam sin nature separated man from God, God said that we are not designed to go alone in life, so God reconciled His lost children back to Him
Read: John 3:16-18
