OUTPOURING PART 4 – Sacrifice and Service

Week 1: I will pour out My Spirit on all flesh

Week 2: God pours out His love into our hearts. God pours out His blessing over us that we will not have room enough to contain it.

Week3: Pentecost Sunday. God poured out His Spirit to 120 people who were filled with the Spirit and became witnesses and spoke in tongues.

But once we have had God's Spirit and God's love poured out over our lives it is impossible to simply just be content with the outpouring from God's side. God has hinged His whole creation on giving and receiving.

- A dam receives rain to give water to city.
- A womb receives seed to give life.
- An employee receives a salary to give a tithe.

It is not one way traffic, but two way traffic.

- We receive grace we give grace.
- We receive love we give love.
- We receive an outpouring of God's Spirit we give back to God and others.

The Bible tells us of a woman who received an outpouring of Jesus grace, forgiveness and mercy and as a result said that no matter what or how much I receive in my life (earthly stuff) I cannot place a value on the outpouring I received over my life through Jesus grace and forgiveness over my life.

1. Poured out precious oil over the head of Jesus.

Read: Mark 14:3 NKJV

Jesus's head represents the head of the church.

Read: Eph. 1:22-23 NKJV

I will pour out my life, my possessions, my time, my everything for the church.

Notice the reaction: Read: Mark 14:4-5 NKJV

- If you haven't received criticism in some way from family or friends or strangers regarding your commitment towards the church then we could question God's Spirit in you.
- Jesus own disciples. They were sinners but hadn't yet experienced what Mary had
- She was caught in adultery but forgiven.
- Her brother was raised from the dead, forever grateful.
- Jesus asks: Who do people say I am disciples Peter?
- On that full persuasion I can build my church.
- On the opinions of people I don't build.
- I am a fool for Jesus. I once was lost but now am found was blind but now I see.

Read: Mark 14:6-9 NKJV

- We want to do things for others through the church
- We do not help the poor at the expense of Jesus
- Your outpouring for Jesus will serve as a memorial for generations to come.

2. Poured out precious oil over the the feet of Jesus.

Read: John 12:1-3 NKJV

- The feet of Jesus represents the victory through Jesus and the taking of the message of the Gospel to all the world.
- Mary washed the feet of Jesus with her glory her hair
- Are you still pouring yourself out for the Gospel?

Read: Ps. 8:6, Is. 52:7 and John 13:3-5 NKJV

- The devil cannot defeat you, he can only tempt you.
- You have to be saved. Pray for the government and for evil that is surrounding us daily

3. Poured Himself out for people.

Read: Phil. 2:17 NKJV

- The only things we can take with us to heaven are people.
 - o People are the reason God sent Jesus and why He died on a cross.
 - o People are the reason God poured out the Holy Spirit.
 - o People are the reason you have a purpose.
 - o People are the reason you will be offended.
 - o People are the reason you will want to quit.
 - o People are the reason you will be told Well Done Good and Faithful Servant.

That is why at CRC: My life has a purpose; the purpose of my life is to win souls (people)

Read: Luke 19:10 NKJV

- Mary's 1st outpouring brought her into the Presence of Jesus.
- Mary's 2nd outpouring activated her Purpose in Jesus.
- Paul's outpouring kept his focus on people.

Read: 2 Tim. 4:6-7 NKJV

Q: Are you still pouring yourself out for Jesus church? The head.

Are you still pouring yourself out and taking your feet to your world for Jesus? The feet.

Are you still pouring yourself out for people? Serving people, disciple people, training people, releasing people?

Read: Eph. 3:14-19 NKJV
