WORD

We are well able to possess it (Part 3)

Read: Num. 13:30 NKJV

- God wants you to possess every promise in His word and to possess your promised land
- God has a place for you, a plan for you, a purpose for you
- God has the right people for you to help you to become everything he has purposed you to be
- God's Promised Land is a land that flows with milk and honey. A land of abundance, fruitfulness, overflow and increase, but in order to take possession of the promises of God for your life, there are giants that need to be overcome.
- 12 went but sadly 10 came back with a bad report

Read: Num. 13:31-32

- Whilst Joshua and Caleb came back with a good report
- Who do you listen to – we are well able or we are not able
- In the same place life is but so is death

Read: Prov. 18:21, Deut. 30:15-16 and Deut. 30:19

- Possession is not a matter of God changing His mind concerning your future but man changing his mouth concerning his future
- In the midst of some of your biggest giants you are needing to overcome
- The difference between winning and losing is advancing or retreating, walking in faith or fear, it will depend whose report you choose to believe

Read: Num. 13:32

- Despite the temporary circumstances or setbacks in your life, and how bad things may seem at times, we choose to believe the report of the Lord

Read: 2 Cor. 4:8-9

- Paul was encouraging himself in the Lord
- Paul was possessing God's promises by believing God's report about his life and not his circumstantial report
- If you want to be and overcomer and a person who possesses every promise of God for your life, you need to be a good report Christian
- You need to carry good report about Jesus's church, His children and His people

Read: Phil. 4:8-9

- Often God's peace is not with people, not because God has changed but our reports have changed
- Whatever things are true, noble, just, pure, lovely and of good report – we are well able
- We need to meditate on the word, about people, the church and the leaders

Read: Prov. 15:30

- The greatest report any human can hear is the good report about God's love towards us
- Nothing can separate us from God's love any longer because of the sacrifice of Jesus our Lord and Saviour
- Isaiah prophesied about Jesus in Is. 53:1-12
- Most people today live with a bad report mindset about their future, faith, families and finance
- We are overcomers because we choose to believe the good news report of Jesus Christ
- In Luke 4 we read about the fulfillment of Isaiah's prophesy when Jesus stood up in the temple and read from the scroll
- For God's assignment to be fulfilled in your life He has to bring you into right alignment

Read: Rom. 2:4 and 2 Thess. 1:11-12
