WELCOME:

WORSHIP

WORD

Let God Arise – Part 2)

Psalm 68:1-6 – Let God arise, Let His enemies be scattered

We saw last week that when God arises, when He is enlarged and magnified in our lives, the enemies are scattered.

Ask a cell member to read 2 Chron. 16:9

God is looking to show Himself strong in your life and He wants to get involved in the battles of your life

Ask a cell member to read Mark 10:27

- Jesus said that when we look to man in our battles and challenges, solutions will seem impossible
- But when we allow God to arise and welcome Him into our battles – nothing is impossible
- The reason many enemies are not being scattered is often that God is not being invited into our battles
- It is a partnership and the Bible says, “With God” and not “For God”
- We must include God all the time

Ask a cell member to read John 5:2-6

- God knows exactly what we are going through and wants to get involved in our battles
- Do not look at man for help when going through battles
- Our circumstances is not our destiny
- When we let God arise in our battles – we rise too
- Jesus will never leave you in the same place you are but will always take you higher

Ask a cell member to read John 10:10

- If we are going through battles for a while and wonder when God is going to come through for us remember we sometimes go through a season of preparation
- Discipline your disappointment and guard your heart at all times
- Apply God in all things and apply your gift in the place of disappointment

Ask a cell member to read Gen. 40:6-8 and Matt. 26:39

- Joseph was outspoken about God and he let God arise in the midst of his disappointment
- Jesus disciplined His disappointment
- The Word of God brings us back to the will of God for our lives

Ask a cell member to read Acts 16:25-26

- Paul went through much for Christ
- People are listening to you when you go through battles – speak faith not fear
- Are you a worshipper in your prison?

QUESTION: What battles are you facing today that you feel disappointment in? What challenge are you facing that feels as if you are going to be defeated?

You need to be like Joseph, Jesus, Paul and Silas and let God arise
Allow God to show Himself strong on your behalf
He is waiting for your invitation to scatter your enemies.
