WORD

Eph. 3:20 AMP

Now to Him who is able to [carry out His purpose and] do superabundantly more than all that we dare ask or think [infinitely beyond our greatest prayers, hopes, or dreams], according to His power that is at work within us,

- God wants to bless you for purpose
- Be expectant for more

Ask a cell member to read 1 Cor. 10:26 TPT

- God will not run out of favour
- God is the God of superabundantly more

Question: What is our God able to do?

- Superabundantly more than all that we dare ask or think.
- Infinitely beyond our greatest prayers
- Our greatest hopes or our greatest dreams.
- According to His power that is at work within us.

Jesus first sermon ever preached was a message of God's ability to do superabundantly more than man was expecting in life.

Ask a cell member to read Luke 4:18-19 NKJV

Question: What message does the Gospel bring to us?

- That our God is able to do what He said He would do
- The Gospel is a message of advancement
- God will fix your broken heart
- The Gospel is a message of liberation
- It is a message of recovery
- It is a message of experience
- It is a message of good news

- The Gospel accepts every single human being

Ask a cell member to read John 3:16

- When the Gospel is heard and received, believed and applied, it leads to lives experiencing superabundantly more than their greatest prayers, hopes and dreams
- God blessed you for purpose
- God wants to give you a hand up
- God makes a covenant with you – not a contract
- The covenant is not changed because you are going through stuff
- A covenant is unbreakable and it is the promises of God. We can hold Him accountable for His word
- The enemy's greatest tactic is to get your focus off the Gospel of hope, onto circumstantial hopelessness
- The Gospel is not a contractual obligation God signs with man, but rather the Gospel is a covenant promise God made with man
- And that is why the Gospel message still is applicable in our lives today
- A contract is breakable and amendable but a covenant is unbreakable and forever set
- A contract is man's limits within the small print of that contract but a covenant is God's unlimited potential within the written print of His word
- Since the time God cut a covenant with man, it was always a message of His ability to do superabundantly more than we thought or asked for

Ask a cell member to read Deut. 11:10-15 NKJV

- God wants you to possess freedom, joy and earthly possessions
- Sow your seed
- Egypt speaks of human effort under bondage and it was a place of limitations
- You must not have a vegetable patch mentality
- Your life is attached to heaven because the covenant is attached to heaven's rain and not a vegetable patch
- God cares about your future – acceptable year of the Lord
- Your life is not attached to something on earth
- Ask God that the rain of heaven come on you and every place that your foot will tread.
- When you walk, you will walk under the covenant of God and always be blessed

Ask a cell member to read John 10:10 and 2 Cor. 9:8

- He wants you to have more and He will give abundantly

Discuss the progress in reaching each person on your Target List. Emphasize the importance of inviting target people to the Celebration service.
