1 Peter 1:6-8 NKJV

Jesus understood this when he chose his 12 disciples, He understood that for his upside down kingdom to be established and advance he needed to not only expose his disciples to this kingdom but test them also.

Jesus tests them in a storm.

Matthew 14:25-26 NKJV

The man they had been following and knew suddenly appeared as a ghost in the middle of a storm.

What the disciples were used to was a right side up understanding. We cannot walk on water so we float on a boat, but what they were experiencing was a man walking on water without a boat.

It was an upside down vision in front of them, and instead of saying: "Hey Jesus what are you doing?"

They said: "It cannot be Jesus it must be a ghost."
