- New opportunities that will follow by release and reward – we must get ready

The number 20 in the Bible symbolizes the cycles of completeness and is associated with a period of waiting, trial and suffering and when the cycle is successfully completed, it is followed by reward and release.

Get ready for the new as the end of the wait is followed by new release and new reward

### ***Read Ezek. 36:26-27***

#### **1. A new heart**

***Read Prov. 13:12***

The Bible speaks of new courage. A new spirit and hope in you

***Read Ps. 20:4***

God wants your plans to succeed but we must first bring change to the inside

#### **2. A new spirit**

***Read Prov. 20:27 and Ps. 143:4***

We think there is no hope in tomorrow but we serve a good, good God  
The Bible speaks of a new vision

***Read Ps. 45:1***

God wants your heart to overflow

### 3. Take out the stony heart

**Read Ezek. 36:26 and Mark 4:16-17**

God wants your heart to overflow

God wants to take out the quit, the fear, predigest and timidity

When a Christian is timid, he is a candidate for intimidation

Fear is the oxygen for intimidation and when the heart is gripped with fear it intimidates us

**Read 2 Tim. 1:7 and Ezek. 36:26**

God has not given us a spirit of fear but of power, love and self-discipline

We have to have a responsive heart toward the Word and a tender heart after God

**Read John 13: 34-35**

God gave us a new commandment

God will help us in times of weakness if we ask – get ready for the new

### 4. Fill you with the Holy Spirit

**Read Ezek. 36:27 and Acts 1:8**

It is about the witness and the life – not about the power.

Grace of God – you will receive power for the purpose that your light will shine. Light only comes when we receive power.

**Read Zech. 4:6 and 2 Cor. 3:16-17**

It is time to turn to the Lord and looking onto Jesus the beginning and finisher of our faith
