## TURN YOUR CRISIS INTO CREATIVITY PART 2

19 JULY 2020

### WELCOME

Welcome all members who are joining the Homecell online.

### WORSHIP

Challenge cell members to spend a few minutes in Worship before your ZOOM/Online Homecell starts. This will create the right atmosphere for your time together.

### WORD

#### Luke 16:8 MSG

*...using every adversity to stimulate you to creative survival,*

#### Ask a cell member to read Genesis 1:1-2

God turned formlessness, emptiness and darkness into creativity when He formed the earth.

#### Ask cell members to read Zechariah 4:6, John 16:7 and Romans 8:11

#### Q: How do these Scriptures relate to Genesis 1 and apply to us today?

- We create our future in the same way that God created the heavens and the earth
- We can only create something *good* and something *lasting* by the power of the Holy Spirit
- The crisis of Calvary was overcome by the Spirit of God
- Every believer has the Spirit of God and therefore the ability to create life in a dead situation

God turned the 'crisis' at Creation into creativity by:

#### 1. Saying

**Genesis 1:3 KJVS**

***And God said, 'Let there be light', and there was light.***

#### Ask cell members to read, Romans 4:17 & Mark 11:23

God has given authority to the believer so that we too can create our future by the power of our words.

#### 2. Seeing

**Genesis 1:4 KJVS**

***And God saw the light, that it was good: and God divided the light from the darkness.***

#### Ask cell members to read Matthew 6:33 & Jeremiah 29:11

God has given us the ability to have a vision of our future, and it is good. Write the vision down!

#### Q: Why is it important for our vision to be attached to purpose?

- Our vision is not for ourselves; it is for kingdom purposes (see Matthew 6:33)

### 3. Sowing

**Genesis 1:11 KJVS**

***And God said, 'Let the earth bring forth grass, the herb yielding seed, and the fruit tree yielding fruit after his kind, whose seed is in itself, upon the earth', and it was so.***

God hinges man's overcoming ability on two fundamental laws that govern the earth:

- a. The law of seedtime and harvest
- b. The law of dominion and control

We first sow seed, then we experience the harvest, and then we have dominion.

**Ask cell members to read Genesis 1:28, 8:22 and 26:1, 3, 12-14**

**Q: Share an example in your own life of where the law of seedtime and harvest has been revealed.**

**Ask cell members to read John 12:24 & Galatians 6:7-9**

**Q: In what area of your life are you currently withholding the right seed or perhaps sowing the wrong seed?**

The laws are not dependent on circumstances such as a pandemic or a lockdown. What you are sowing now, is what you will reap in the next season.

**God, our Creator and Creative Force, has not created man to be overcome by crisis but to conquer crisis through creativity!**

## WORKS

As a Homecell, identify the most pressing needs (among people in your immediate world) that should be addressed a.s.a.p. (include the following: food needs, people who are staying alone, marriage challenges, financial needs, business/career needs, emotional needs etc.) As a Homecell, how can you assist in meeting some of these needs?
