#### VICTORY

**1 Corinthians 15:57 NKJV**

***But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.***

“Victory” means “a conquest that leads to triumph over”. Jesus has conquered sin and death and brought victory to us through His death and resurrection.

Victory doesn't come through politics, sport, the economy, our natural vision or our natural value by itself. God gives us the victory through Jesus. Having a vision and value apart from Christ is self-centred and selfish (Luke 9:25). God never intended for man to gain victory on earth by himself.

The enemy will always try to make you believe you have to fight **for** victory when in fact we fight **from** victory.

**Ask a cell member to read Philippians 4:19**

**Ps Aidan gave us a few victory benefit reminders:**

- Live under grace and truth (John 1:17)

**Ask cell members to read John 1:17, 2 Corinthians 12:9 & Hebrews 4:16**

**Q: What does it mean to 'live under grace'?**

- Grace is not an excuse to sin
- Grace empowers us to live for the glory of God
- Walk in peace with God (Romans 5:1)
- Able to give glory to God (Romans 16:27)
- Able to be comforted by God (2 Corinthians 1:5)
- Able to trust God (2 Corinthians 3:4-5)
- Able to walk in abundance (2 Corinthians 8:9)
- Can do more because of Christ's strength (Philippians 4:13)
- Walk in the power of the Holy Spirit (Titus 3:6)

- Live lives of sacrifice (1 Peter 2:5)
- Look forward to our eternal inheritance (Galatians 4:7)
- Obtain salvation (1 Thessalonians 5:9)

**Q: Which benefit reminder that Ps Aidan gave us spoke the most to you? Why?**

**Ask cell members to read Philippians 3:7-11 and Ephesians 3:8-12**

**Q: Our victory comes through Christ; He is the lens through which we view the world. When last did you study the nature of Christ?**

**We have the victory over sin & death! We serve a God that is leading us into victory & triumph no matter what! Declare the name of Jesus over every circumstance!**
