Prov. 29:18 Voice

Where there is no vision from God, the people run wild, but those who adhere to God's instruction know genuine happiness.

- Vision shows us a picture of the future
- Vision helps us place boundaries in our lives
- Vision helps us make clearer decisions

This week we will continue looking at **VALUE**

Q: How valuable are you? Did you know you get paid in relation to the value you bring to the marketplace?

The Bible equates many aspects of our lives in value

Meaning of Value – having considerable monetary worth

- You have to add value to your vision

Read Rom. 6:23 - The Bible puts a value to sin and the value to sin is death

Read Matt. 16:26 – What value do you put to your eternity? Are you adding value to God's Kingdom?

Read 1 Pet. 1:18-19 and Acts 20:28

- The Bible says that Jesus and His blood is precious (valuable)
- Jesus paid the ultimate price and His precious blood saved you

Read Matt. 13:45-46

- Jesus was God's most precious gift, which still has value up until today
- We should be more excellent than our neighbour because of Christ in us

Q: Can you imagine if Jesus blood ran out of value? It no longer was precious?

- We expect Jesus blood to be valuable and maintain value, but when it comes to our own lives we often neglect our value component

- Very often we don't experience victory in our vision and goals because of limited or lack of value
- When you put value and vision together you get victory

Read Col. 2:15

Q: Can you imagine if Jesus blood ran out of value? It no longer was previous?

- We need to keep on increasing our value component

1 Tim. 5:17 – If you work well you should be paid well

Prov. 14:23 – if you work hard you will have great abundance

Prov. 22:29 – you will be promoted

Three G's to increasing value

Read Prov. 24:3-4 – you will have to build an enterprise and increase your value component

1. In Getting (The books we read)

Read Prov. 4:7. Prov. 23:23

- Get wisdom and good judgement
- Salvation is the starting stage of forming
- God blesses you for purpose

Q: What have you read in the past 6 months that once you have read it and applied it to your life will show an upward mobilization of your income?

Read Eccl. 10:10

- Apply your mind
- Knowledge navigates you through all your problems
- We must buy wisdom – invest in your mind

2. In Greeting (The people we meet)

Read Rom. 21:24

- Relationships are the network of life
- Your relationship with Jesus gives you access to God and heaven
- Relationships and value go together and open doors

Read Luke 16:8-9

3. In Going (The places we go)

Read Num. 13:30. Jud. 6:12,14 and Matt. 28:19-20

- Go and take possession – sharpen your axe
