GOD WILL PULL YOU INTO VICTORY

17 JANUARY 2021

WELCOME

Welcome all members who are joining the Homecell online.

WORSHIP

Challenge cell members to spend a few minutes in Worship before your ZOOM/Online Homecell starts. This will create the right atmosphere for your time together.

WORD

Psalm 31:1-2 TPT

I trust you, Lord, to be my hiding place. Don't let me down. Don't let my enemies bring me to shame. Come and rescue me, for you are the only God who always does what is right. Rescue me quickly when I cry out to you. At the sound of my prayer may your ear be turned to me. Be my strong shelter and hiding place on high. Pull me into victory and breakthrough.

Whenever someone needs to be pulled its most likely because they are stuck. Lockdown has caused a lot of people to feel stuck.

No matter how stuck you may be or seem to be, God is going to pull you into victory and breakthrough!

Ask a cell member to read Matthew 14:24-27

Q: What was the first thing Jesus said when His disciples saw Him? Why do you think He spoke to them rather than to the wind and waves?

- Jesus wanted them to use their faith in the middle of the storm
- He wanted them to choose courage over fear
- He wanted them to trust Him

Ask a cell member to read Matthew 14:28-31 and Luke 17:6

Q: What part did Peter play in walking on the water after Jesus had pulled him up?

- Jesus didn't pull Peter into permanent victory
- Peter had to use his faith again
- Faith pulls up

Q: Do you think Peter's faith was stronger after this situation? Why do you say that?

We can do 3 things while we are waiting for God to pull us into victory:

1. Trust again (Psalm 31:1a TPT)

Ask cell members to read Psalm 31:1 (TPT), 2 Timothy 2:13 & Jeremiah 17:5, 7

Q: What can we trust God for according to the Psalmist?

- God WILL keep you safe

- God WILL protect you from shame
- God WILL do what is right for you

2. Cry out to God again

Ask cell members to read Psalm 31:2 (TPT) & Jeremiah 29:11-12

Q: Do you think crying out to God is an act of faith? Why?

- Sometimes our circumstances cause us to shut down and keep quiet
- Praising God and calling out to God in our trouble is an act of faith because we are trusting Him to pull us out
- Don't be silent. Praise again! Pray again!

3. Give God glory again

Ask cell members to read Psalm 31:3-4 (TPT) & Psalm 40:1-4

God will use whatever you are going through for His glory. Trust that something good is going to come out of your situation.

God will pull you into victory and breakthrough!

WORKS

As a Homecell, identify the most pressing needs (among people in your immediate world) that should be addressed a.s.a.p. (include the following: food needs, people who are staying alone, marriage challenges, financial needs, business/career needs, emotional needs etc.) As a Homecell, how can you assist in meeting some of these needs?
