WORD

Last week we heard that God will pull us into victory if we trust again, cry out to God again and give God the glory again.

God is not only the God of the pull He is also the God of the push.

Ps. 24:2 TPT

He's the one who pushed back oceans to let the dry ground appear, planting firm foundations for the earth.

- The Bible says when God created the heavens and the earth He pushed back the waters to reveal dry ground
- When we are in deep waters or when we are in a storm on the water, the place we long for is dry ground
- When the disciples found themselves in a storm on the sea of Galilee the boat represented dry ground
- When Peter was on the water in the storm and looking at Jesus he kept afloat, but the minute he started to look at the storm he started to drown
- What we look at the longest will become the strongest.

Read Matt. 14:31-32 TPT

- God will push back the storm to get you onto dry ground
- God will walk through your troubles with you and calm your problems

Read Mark 4:39 NKJV and 4:40 TPT

- It is in the storm that we must learn to trust
- He will never leave us or forsake us

Read Ex. 14:13-16 NKJV and 21-22 TLB

- The Bible says that at one-time Moses and the Israelites also found themselves in a storm
- Pharaoh and his army were chasing them from one side and the red sea was blocking their escape from the other side
- It was another trust lesson for Moses and God's children
- Don't be afraid – see the salvation of the Lord

- God does not say we must stand still and do nothing – we must face the storm
- Speak the mountain and look what is in your hand. God gives us an instruction in the midst of a storm
- What seems impossible to man will be possible for God
- God will push back the waters of resistance or the waters of turmoil and guide you through to the other-side on dry ground

Read Prov. 3:5-6 NKJV

- We need to trust in the Lord with all our heart and lean not on our own understanding
- It is in the storm that we need to trust
- It is in the still that we need to worship

Read Matt. 14:32-33 TPT

- When we feel overcome we trust
- When we do overcome we worship

Read Ps. 44:5-8 TPT

- When we feel overcome we trust
- Pause in His presence
