## WELCOME

Welcome all members who are joining the Homecell online.

## WORSHIP

Challenge cell members to spend a few minutes in Worship before your ZOOM/Online Homecell starts. This will create the right atmosphere for your time together.

## WORD

### **Zechariah 4:11-14 TLB**

*Then I asked him about the two olive trees on each side of the lampstand, [12] and about the two olive branches that emptied oil into gold bowls through two gold tubes. [13] "Don't you know?" he asked. "No, sir," I said. [14] Then he told me, "They represent the two anointed ones who assist the Lord of all the earth."*

The two olive trees are Zerubbabel, who represents the king, and Joshua, who represents the priest.

### **Ask a cell member to read 1 Corinthians 3:9**

**Q: Paul calls us co-workers with God. What do you think that means?**

- You have a part to play in your business to represent the kingdom and expand the kingdom
- God values people, so we must value people
- God needs you to recover in person so that other people who have not yet been impacted by the Gospel can be reached
- As both Joshua and Zerubbabel had a part to play, so too the Church depends for its vitality upon both the pastors and the members

Ps Aidan shared 7 responsibilities that every Christian has in ensuring the flow to every lamp stays open. Every Christian has a role and responsibility in all 7.

Every Christian is responsible:

1. To build relationships with the unchurched
2. To share their verbal testimony
3. To invite the unchurched to church
4. To invite the unchurched and newly saved to homecells
5. To be planted in the local church
6. To serve in the local church
7. To steward their financial resources in the church

### **Ask a cell member to read Matthew 11:19**

**Q: What are some of the ways in which we can befriend the sinners in our world?**

**Ask cell members to read Revelation 12:11, Acts 1:8 and Acts 4:8-12**

**Q: What prevents us from sharing our testimony? How can we overcome that?**

**Ask cell members to read John 4:29-30 & John 1:40-42**

**Q: Who was the person who invited you to church? How did God use them to influence your life? What can you learn from that?**

You were so important to God that he used someone else to influence your life, disrupt your plans and invite you to church. Someone is waiting on the other side of your obedience!

**Ask cell members to read Acts 2:42-47 and Romans 12:5-8, 13**

**Q: Why do you think God called us to be planted in a local church? What are the benefits you've experienced from being planted and from serving?**

**Ask cell members to read 1 Corinthians 16:2, Luke 19:8 and Luke 6:38**

**Q: How have you been challenged in the area of generosity before? What encouragement would you give someone struggling with that right now?**

**Think about which lamp of your responsibility towards God's church is burning dim or even off. Take one step towards changing that today!**

## WORKS

Pray for your homecell's target list and encourage people to share their testimony and/or invite someone to church this Sunday.

As a homecell, identify the most pressing needs (among people in your immediate world) that should be addressed a.s.a.p.
