## WELCOME

## WORSHIP

Challenge cell members to spend a few minutes in Worship before your ZOOM/Online Homecell starts. This will create the right atmosphere for your time together.

## WORD

Last week we heard that God will recover in power and that God's work will be accomplished by God's Spirit and God's grace

**Zech. 4:6-7 TLB**

***"Not by might, nor by power, but by my Spirit, says the Lord Almighty, you will succeed because of my Spirit"***

Today we will look at: **Recover in purpose**

**2. God's work must not be despised for its small beginnings**

***Ask a cell member to read Zechariah 4:8-10***

- So often when we think recovery or even receive a promise from God it has the end in mind

***Ask a cell member to read Prov. 3:10, Mal.3:10 and Zach. 4:10 TLB***

- God's promise is to recover all; however, the end is recover all, but the beginning will be start small
- God says that he will prove that he is alive if we put our trust in Him
- Zerubbabel had to be reminder not to be ungrateful because the recovery looked small
- Nothing big starts big, everything big starts small

***Ask a cell member to read Matt. 6:9-11 NKJV***

- Pray every day that you will have what you need
- Pray and learn to be grateful day by day
- God wants to give to you for purpose
- God will let you recover so that His Kingdom can be blessed
- You have to stay active in your Christianity

***Ask a cell member to read Col. 3:15 NKJV***

- Paul says people without the peace of God ruling in their hearts are never thankful or grateful
- Outside the Spirit of God, you cannot have peace with God
- Let the peace of God rule in your heart
- God does not bless us for our sake He always blesses for Kingdom purpose
- Kingdom promise is attached to Kingdom purpose

**Ask a cell member to read Matt. 17:24-27**

- Kingdom purpose is always preceded by sacrifice not stimulus
- God will make a way where there is no way. He can do all things
- The Kingdom of God is built on sacrifice
- The Spirit of God will strengthen us within our sacrifice

**Q: What precedes Kingdom Provision?**

- Kingdom sacrifice – Prov. 3:9-10 and Mal. 3:10
- Kingdom promise of provision – Mal.3:10b

**Q: Are you willing no to despise the days of small beginnings? Are you ready to keep sacrificially pressing into God and His Kingdom?**

**Ask a cell member to read Zech. 4:10A and Gal. 6:9 TLB**

- You will only recover all in sacrifice for Him
- You will see God's hand of restoration in 2021
