WELCOME

Welcome all members who are joining the Homecell online.

WORSHIP

Challenge cell members to spend a few minutes in Worship before ZOOM/Online Homecell Starts. This will create the right atmosphere for your time together.

WORD

Acts 3:26 NKJV

To you first, God, having raised up His Servant Jesus, sent Him to bless you, in turning away every one of you from your iniquities."

Ask a cell members to read Acts 3:1-21

Q: By looking at these verses why do you think this seen as such a significant miracle?

- First miracle that took place after the Pentecost
- Demonstration that the same authority that Jesus had was given to men by the power of the Holy Spirit.

Q: Do you think that the same power is available today?

Gods not dead ...that God is still healing the sick, God is still preaching good news to the poor, still healing broken hearts, still setting captives free, still setting the oppressed free and still declaring that this is the acceptable year of the Lord.... The pain of the cross and the power in the cave was to manifest to us so that you and I could have the purpose of heavens commission.

1. God is personal

Ask a cell members to read John 16:7 NKJV

Q: Why would you say Jesus deemed it important for Him to go away?

- In order for us to receive the Holy Spirit
- Jesus could only be in one place – but the Holy Spirit who works within us is omnipresent.

Ask a cell members to read Acts 9:4-5 NKJV

Q: Why would you say it is important to have a personal encounter with God?

- God is personal and wants a personal relationship with us.
- The Holy Spirit operates in an through us uniquely therefore no miracles gets repeated twice

2. God is powerful:

Ask a few cell members to read Acts 3:16, Romans 8:37 and Ephesians 3:20

Q: Where in your life have you given God something small and He multiplied?

Where not asked to feed the 5000 but when we bring our loaves and fish He is able to use our mustard seed faith to feed the thousands.

3. God is purposeful:

Ask a few cell members to read Luke 5:49, Acts 9:6 and Matthew 28:18-20

Q: According to these verses what is the purpose of God's power?

- "preach the kingdom of God to the other cities also"
- "Arise and go into the city, and you will be told what you must do."
- "Now go in my authority and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them"

4. God is prosperous:

Ask a few members to read Romans 2:4, 3 John 1:2, Romans 15:29 and Philippians 1:6

Q: What do these verses teach us about God's character?

- "extraordinary kindness"
- "pray that you may prosper"
- "faithfully continue the process of maturing you."
- "I shall come in the fullness of the blessing"
- We serve a kind, understanding and generous God who wants us to experience prosperity and blessings in abundance. He is faithful in providing exceedingly and abundantly.
- God isn't the God of doom.

If He did it then, He can do it now. If He did it for me, He can do it for you. God is NOT dead, therefore God is NOT done.
