WELCOME

Welcome all members who are joining the Homecell online.

WORSHIP

Challenge cell members to spend a few minutes in Worship before your ZOOM/Online Homecell starts. This will create the right atmosphere for your time together.

WORD

Psalm 22:22-31 MSG

Here's the story I'll tell my friends when they come to worship, and punctuate it with Hallelujahs: Shout Hallelujah, you God-worshippers; give glory, you sons of Jacob; adore him, you daughters of Israel. He has never let you down, never looked the other way when you were being kicked around. He has never wandered off to do his own thing; he has been right there, listening. [25-26] Here in this great gathering for worship I have discovered this praise-life. And I'll do what I promised right here in front of the God-worshippers. Down-and-outers sit at GOD's table and eat their fill. Everyone on the hunt for God is here, praising him. "Live it up, from head to toe. Don't ever quit!" [27-28] From the four corners of the earth people are coming to their senses, are running back to GOD. Long-lost families are falling on their faces before him. GOD has taken charge; from now on he has the last word. [29] All the power-mongers are before him -worshipping! All the poor and powerless, too - worshipping! Along with those who never got it together - worshipping! [30-31] Our children and their children will get in on this. As the word is passed along from parent to child. Babies not yet conceived will hear the good news - that God does what he says.

God is going to restore your shout!

In Hebrew, the word SHOUT is *roo-ah'*, which means to split the ears with sound.

Ask a cell member to read Psalm 47:1

Shouting unto God positions us for triumph or victory. Whenever God brought restoration and recovery to His children, it was preceded with a shout.

Ask a few cell members to read Joshua 6:15-17, 20 and Judges 7:16-22

Joshua took back Jericho; Gideon took back the city.

Q: What walls of resistance are you facing? Perhaps they're walls that you have built yourself. Insecurity? Doubt? Fear?

The Bible says shout! The walls of Jericho are coming down.

Ask a few cell members to read Psalm 95:1-5; Psalm 96:2-3 and Psalm 98:4-6

Q: Why do we shout and praise and worship?

- 1. God has never let us down**
Psalm 22:24a; Romans 8:31
- 2. God has never looked the other way**
Psalm 22:24b; 2 Corinthians 4:8-9, 16
- 3. God has never wandered off to do His own thing**
Psalm 22:24c; 2 Timothy 2:13

Q: Are you ready to shout your hallelujahs to our God?

Don't think your worship is in vain or has no effect.

Ask a few cell members to read Psalm 22:25-31 MSG and Matthew 20:30-33 TPT

Your shout gets God's attention!

Shout hallelujah you God-worshippers!
