## BE A WOW WOMEN

### WELCOME

Welcome all members who are joining the Homecell online.

### WORSHIP

Challenge cell members to spend a few minutes in Worship before your ZOOM/Online Homecell starts. This will create the right atmosphere for your time together.

### WORD

#### **Genesis 2:21-23 NKJV**

*And the LORD God caused a deep sleep to fall on Adam, and he slept; and He took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh in its place. [22] Then the rib which the LORD God had taken from man He made into a woman, and He brought her to the man. [23] And Adam said: "This is now bone of my bones And flesh of my flesh; She shall be called Woman, Because she was taken out of Man."*

In last Sunday's message, in celebration of Mother's Day, Ps Aidan focussed on being a WOW woman. This week we will reflect on the examples of WOW woman from the word and how we can use these examples to be prosperous in our walk of faith. We will look at Sarah, Rahab, Mary and lastly YOU.

#### **1. SARAH - (WOMAN OF WAIT- ENDURANCE ,PATIENCE )**

**Ask a homecell member to read Genesis 17:15-16 NKJV**

**Q: Have you received a word or promise from God?**  
(self-reflection)

**Q: Why can you undoubtedly stand on the promises of God?**

- His promises are always Yes and Amen
- God never changes His mind
- He is our steadfast rock
- Even if it takes years until fulfilment - His promises stand regardless.

**Ask a homecell member to read Hebrews 11:11 NKJV**

**Q: By looking at this verse how do you think we should tackle our seasons of waiting?**

- By staying faithful
- Praying persistently
- Keeping His promise at hand and not wander off to "plan B"
- Staying patient
- Worshipping God in all forms and with all aspects of our lives

#### **2. RAHAB - (WOMAN OF WORTH-COURAGE AND FAITH)**

**Ask a Homecell member to read the following scripture Joshua 2:1 NLT, 1 Samuel 16:7b NLT, Romans 3:23-24 TLB and Hebrews 11:30-31 NKJV.**

**Q: By looking at these verses – do you think that our natural aspects and past can place a limitation on God's promises and abilities? And why?**

(no)

- God used a prostitute purposefully in His plan - in her generation and generations to come.
- God does not call the qualified, but He qualifies the called.
- God does not place a value on our outer appearance but looks at our hearts .
- God sees worth differently and someone/ something that looks worthless to the world is worthy to God.
- God doesn't look at your past but sees your belief in your current circumstances

**Q: Why do you think it is important to live by grace and not the law?**

- We can't add any part to our own salvation, otherwise the crucifixion could be seen as redundant
- God understands our natural shortcomings
- God can only be pleased by our faith

**Ask a Homecell member to read the following scripture Matthew 1:5-6 NLT:**

**Q: When reflecting on this verse, can you see how one woman's obedience lead to generational blessings? Are you ready to be the part of the reason why your generations to come will be born into a Jesus-magnifying environment?**

### **3. MARY - (WOMAN OF WORSHIP, WORD AND WARFARE)**

**Ask a Homecell member to read the Luke 1:38 NKJV and Hebrews 4:12 TPT.**

**Q: Why is it important that we become a nation that submits unto God's word?**

- Our obedience unto God's word enables Him to perform miracles in and through us
- When submitting unto God's word we become humble servants – honouring Him with a sacrificial life
- We position ourselves to perform God's purpose for our lives.

**Ask a Homecell member to read Hebrews 4:12 TPT.**

**Q: By looking at this verse we get insight into the power of God's word.**

**How will you say, can we live out the power of God's word in our daily circumstances?**

- Speaking the word over your circumstances.
- Be a living example of God's word.
- Praying the word over every circumstance that you find yourself in
- By understanding the word we learn to fully understand worship
- By spending intentional time in the word we cloak ourselves with Godly authority

### **4. A WOMAN/ MAN OF WILL YOU?**

*The fourth WOW woman/ man is YOU – if you are willing to, He is able to.*

**Q: Are you willing to turn from a Will you woman/ man into a WOW woman/man of God?**

**RISE UP WOMAN OF GOD AND BE A WOW WOMAN...GOD NEEDS YOU,THE CHURCH NEEDS YOU,SOCIETY NEEDS YOU,YOUR FAMILY NEEDS YOU**
