### WELCOME

Welcome all members who are joining the Homecell online.

### WORSHIP

Challenge cell members to spend a few minutes in Worship before your ZOOM/Online Homecell starts. This will create the right atmosphere for your time together.

### WORD

#### **Matthew 20:32 NKJV**

*So Jesus stood still and called them, and said, "What do you want Me to do for you?"*

Sunday Ps Aidan started a new series called "What do you want Me to do for you" with the eye on not just restoring all, but becoming a bigger, better and bolder you than ever before.

#### **Ask a homecell member to read Matthew 20:32.**

**Q: What do YOU want?**

(ask as a rhetorical question to let HC Members think about as HC continues)

#### **Ask a homecell member to read Matthew 20:30-31**

**Q: Why do you think it is necessary to be desperate for change?**

- Desperation leads to action
- Desperation leads to a fully persuaded answer towards what you want God to do for you
- In desperate times we seek God and His touch fully

#### **Ask a few members to read Matthew 20:33 and Matthew 20:34 NKJV**

**Q: By looking at these verses, it is important to realise that in order for the blessing to be received, something had to be removed, in this case blindness out and sight in.**

**What do you have to remove in your life to make room to receive a blessing?**

(homecell members to reflect)

#### **Ask a Homecell member to read the following scripture Romans 12:2 NLT**

**Q: By looking at this verse, why would you say it is important that we do not conform to this world?**

- To not allow the conditions of this world to form who we are
- To not adapt the negative mindset of this world
- To stand out from instead of blending into this world
- And to be renewed to a positive mindset daily

In order to see the result of what you asked God to do for you, we have to do 3 practical things:

**1. Write down the vision:**

**Ask a Homecell member to read Habakkuk 2:2a MSG**

**Q: Why is it important that we write our vision down?**

- What the mind conceives the heart can believe
- Once we see where we want to go, we can start thinking practically about how to get there
- We can show others so they can also physically see where you are headed
- If people can see the vision they can easily buy in to receive the result

**2. Take visible action:**

**Ask a Homecell member to read the following scriptures Habakkuk 2:2b MSG, Ecclesiastes 5:3 NKJV and Matthew 7:7 NKJV**

**Q: according to these verses why is it important that we add action to our vision?**

- A vision without an action will stay a vision
- Action brings forth change
- In order to receive the blessing we must position ourselves first to receive it

**3. Show visible persistence:**

**Ask a Homecell member to read Habakkuk 2:3 MSG and Galatians 6:9 NLT**

**Q: according to these verses why should we stay persistent?**

- Even if it takes time the harvest WILL come

**Q: What can we do to stay persistent in our race?**

- Do not give up
- Keep on seeking God and keep on asking for answers.
- Always have the end goal in mind
- Surround yourself with people that will pull you towards your desired result and not push you away.
