## BELIEVE, BUILD, BREAK OUT PART 2

29 AUGUST 2021

### WELCOME

Welcome all members who are joining the Homecell and online.

### WORSHIP

Prepare Praise and Worship for the Homecell gathering (1 Praise & 2 Worship songs).

### WORD

#### Mark 9:23 NKJV

*"Jesus said to him, "If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes."*

Last week we started the series by looking at the power of what we believe and how the enemy is after our belief. If the enemy can get you to stop believing he can get you to stop building. We continue with Ps Aidan's series, considering that God does everything on earth through **building**.

#### Proverbs 23:7 NKJV

*"For as he thinks in his heart, so is he."*

God sent Jesus to set man free from the bondage of sin, and the limitations and self-imposed prisons in his mind.

#### Ask a few cell members to read Luke 4:18, Matthew 16:18 and 1 Peter 2:5

Jesus sets us free to build His church and to build us!

The Bible calls the enemy the accuser and a thief. He will accuse you through criticism or steal your confidence through fear.

#### 1. Criticism

Nehemiah came up against this criticism tactic when rebuilding the walls of Jerusalem.

**Ask a cell member to read Nehemiah 2:18-19**

**Q: When have you experienced criticism that stole your confidence? What impact did it have on you?**

#### 2. Fear

When they couldn't stop Nehemiah from building through criticism they thought, "Let's intimidate him".

**Ask a cell member to read Nehemiah 6:1-3**

**Q: What kind of distractions has the enemy used to intimidate you before? How has that made you wiser?**

### **Ask a cell member to read 2 Timothy 1:6-8**

When Timothy was building, he also had to be reminded not to allow criticism and fear to derail him.

**Q: Can you think of a time when a more mature believer came alongside you and encouraged you in your faith? What did they say or do that had such an influence on you?**

Ps Aidan shared 3 keys to purposeful building:

**1. Purpose to build Jesus's church.**

**Ask a cell member to read Ephesians 4:12**

**2. Purpose to build yourself**

**Ask a cell member to read Jude 1:20**

**3. Purpose to build others**

**Ask a cell member to read 1 Corinthians 14:17**

**Q: On a scale of 1-10 where would you say you are in terms of purposeful building (if 1 was maintaining or surviving and 10 was actively building or advancing)?**

Cell members can volunteer to answer or just personally reflect on this.

Perhaps they are on the wall and need to be determined to stay and build! Or perhaps they need to get back on the wall and build again!

**Don't be afraid of the attacks of the enemy! You can build that dream that God has given you!  
God's grace is sufficient for you!**

## WORKS

Linked to key 3 that Pastor Aidan shared (purpose to build others), discuss Monday evening's sponsor-sponsee training with your homecell members. Encourage them to take up the responsibility of investing into a younger believer that's either in the homecell or someone that they know.

Please make sure your homecell members book for Sunday's service in homecell if they haven't done so already.

As a Homecell, identify the most pressing needs (among people in your immediate world) that should be addressed a.s.a.p. (include the following: food needs, people who are staying alone, marriage challenges, financial needs, business/career needs, emotional needs etc.) As a Homecell, how can you assist in meeting some of these needs?
