BELIEVE, BUILD, BREAK OUT #1

WELCOME

Welcome all members who are joining the Homecell online.

WORSHIP

Challenge cell members to spend a few minutes in Worship before your ZOOM/Online Homecell starts. This will create the right atmosphere for your time together.

WORD

Mark 9:23 NKJV

Jesus said to him, "If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes."

In this Sunday's message Ps Aidan started a new series called Believe, Build and Break Out. This week we are going to take a moment to reflect on Believe.

Ask a cell members to read Mark 9:23

Q: According to this verse, do you think what you believe is important and why would you say it is important for us to stand firm in what we believe in?

- We will be able according to what we believe
- The enemy is after our belief
- If the enemy can influence or change what we believe then he can change what we build
- Altering your belief can influence your breakthrough

Ask a cell members to read Mark 9:24

Q: Why would you say the father in this verse asked the Lord to help him with his unbelief?

- He understood that his unbelief was influencing not only his breakthrough but his child's breakthrough as well.

Q: When you were in a place of unbelief what did you do practically to change your unbelief into belief?

(Allow members to share different approaches)

Ask a homecell member to read 2 Chronicles 20:20 NKJV

By looking at this verse, we get a clear understanding that something is required from us to be able to prosper:

- 1. Believing in God
- 2. Believing in His prophetic word

Ask a homecell member 2 Chronicles 20:15 NKJV and 2 Chronicles 20:17

When Jehoshaphat went into battle God gave Him a word to stand on which enabled him to oppose the enemy with confidence.

Q: How do you position yourself to believe?

Position yourself in God's presence in front of His word.

We need to train ourselves to position ourselves in front of God's Word, which holds our minds during these times.

Q: How does God's Word hold your mind?

- His Word is filled with promises of victorious outcome
- His promises are what we believe when facing opposition

Ask a few homecell members to read 2 Peter 1:19a NKJV, Psalm 119:105 and John 8:12 NKJV These verses are focussed on His Word bringing and being the light in our lives.

Q: How can you shape your future with His word?

- Don't profess your unbelief instead prophecy your belief
- Don't hold unto excuses
- Prophecy His Promises

Ask a homecell member to read Matthew 9:28b

By looking at these verses, we see that our belief in the word is our seed for our miracles. Q: In which area of your life are you believing God for His word to become flesh?

Ask a cell member to read Philippians 4:19 and Ephesians 3:20

Q: What are you prophesying over your life, God's prophetic word or your unbelief?
