## MOVE PART 1

01 August 2021

### WELCOME

Welcome all members who are joining the Homecell online.

### WORSHIP

Challenge cell members to spend a few minutes in Worship before your ZOOM/Online Homecell starts. This will create the right atmosphere for your time together.

### WORD

#### **Acts 17:28a KJV**

*For in him we live, and move, and have our being.*

In last Sunday's message Ps Aiden started a new series called Move! Living required movement and during this week we will focus on equipping ourselves to move in order to outwit the enemy. The greater the restriction the greater the move!

#### **Ask a cell members to read John 9:4 CSB**

**Q: What is the work that God trusted YOU with – personally, us as a vision, as well as us as Christians?**

(Rhetorical question to remind members about their personal conviction as well as the mission of our church and the great commission.)

**Q: Why is it important for us to choose to MOVE for God?**

- The church moves when we decide to move
- When we move in the spiritual realm the natural will follow
- We will be help accountable personally for what we did with the work He entrusted us with while we were on earth.

#### **Ask a homecell member to read John 5:2-9.**

**By looking at these verses, we can see the consequences of not moving as well as the result of moving.**

#### **Ask a cell member to read John 5:3 TLB**

**Q: When we look at these verses, what is the impact that our community, or the people and things that we surround ourselves with, has on us?**

- If we surround ourselves with negative people we will become or stay negative
- People can either challenge you to do better and grow (heal) or create a "by the way" environment where sickness and accepted

- What you surround yourself with becomes our truth – if we are constantly surrounded by negativity and illness we will start to accept that that is all there is.

**Ask a cell member to read John 5:4 and Matthew 6:33 NKJV**

By looking at this verse it is very clear that the FIRST person is the one who receives the healing. Luckily the bible doesn't tell us to be first, the bible tells us to seek first.

**Q: What does it look like to actively seek first His Kingdom?**

- Jesus is the Kingdom personified – we must be after His heart first.
- Pressing into inner time moving closer to Him.
- Sacrificing to build His church.
- Prioritising your life to revolve around Him

**Ask a cell member to read John 5:5**

**Q: How long will you lie there, sit there, hide there before you move?**

**Ask a cell member to read John 5:6 and John 5:7**

**Q: What things in our life have we started to accept instead of challenge to change because we have been camping in a place of comfort for too long?**

**Q: Why is it important to want to get well first?**

- What we want in our heart is what we'll achieve in actions
- A positive mindset leads to a healthy life
- God won't heal what we don't allow Him to
- We need to be in a place of wanting to restore all and believing it before just asking for it

**Ask a cell member to read Matthew 7:7 and Matthew 7:8-11**

**Q: Why is it important to stay in motion?**

- When we stay in motion we experience God's power.
- Not moving will cause you to stay stagnant and produce poor results
- Jesus was clear that we should remain in motion to experience God's Power.

**Q: According to these verses what does it look like to move?**

- Asking is moving
- Seeking is moving
- Knocking is moving  
(encourage members to open conversation on spending time in fellowship, seeking mentorship, etc.)

**Ask a member to read John 5:8-9 TLB**

In order to receive healing Jesus made him move. By looking at verse 9 Jesus instructed him to go to a different location after he was healed.

**Q: Which places in your life is Jesus instructing you to go from and which places is He instructing you to go to?**

**End of by asking a member to read Acts 20:24:**

We are not moved by this world but we move to better this world.
