## WORD

**QUESTION 1:** What is your most favorite memory of Dreamweek 2021?

**QUESTION 2:** What is the ONE thing you're taking away from Dreamweek 2021?

Ask a cell member to read Joel 2:28-29

**QUESTION 3:** God said that a clear distinguishing factor of the last days will be that His servants will have visions and dreams. What has God, in the past few months, stirred in your heart concerning your future?

Ask a few cell members to read Matthew 5:13-16 & Luke 14:34-35

**QUESTION 4:** As a Church it's our desire to see that poverty be eradicated from our nation. What role should we as Christians play in bringing change to our communities?

*Answer: Salt makes a difference in its environment by being totally different than its environment. Salt was primarily used for two things: 1. fertilizer – you put salt in the soil to make good things to grow; 2. disinfectant – to stop the spread and growth of things you don't want to grow. As God's children we're suppose to enhance the good in our world but also to actively work against anything that wants to corrode and erode.*

Ask a cell member to read 1 Corinthians 2:9-10

**QUESTION 5:** What would you say is the relevance of this scripture for us living in South Africa during 2021?

*Answer: No matter where or when you live, God has the answer and solution to your life and situation. God's vision for us is not dependent on our circumstances. Our responsibility is to hear from God!*

Ask a cell member to read Joel 2:28-29 again

**QUESTION 6:** Both Paul (1 Cor. 2) and Joel (Joel 2) talks about the importance of the work of the Spirit of God. What role does the Holy Spirit play in the process of vision?

*Answer: The Holy Spirit is the Initiator and Inspirer of vision. Without the work of the Holy Spirit in our lives we'll never have God-inspired vision. (Look at Philippians 2:12-13)*

## **2 Peter 1:19 The Message**

*We couldn't be more sure of what we saw and heard—God's glory, God's voice. The prophetic Word was confirmed to us. You'll do well to keep focusing on it. It's the one light you have in a dark time as you wait for daybreak and the rising of the Morning Star in your hearts.*

**QUESTION 7:** What role would you say does prophecy play in ensuring the realization of God's vision for us?

*Answer: Prophecy is a powerful tool to bring the unseen/invisible into the seen/visible. It's by prophesying God's Word/Vision over our current situation that we'll see it change. It's also a means to keep us focused on God's promise especially when we go through a dark time.*

Ask a cell member to read Isaiah 55:11

**QUESTION 8:** What does this scripture teach us about how God accomplishes things?

*Answer: Even God operates according to the principle of prophecy. This should encourage us to never stop speaking the promises/vision/dream God gave us. We'll speak our dream/vision/promise into existence.*

**Many people are using words to describe their situation instead of using God's Word to change their situation!**
