WORD

Joel 2:28 NKJV

"And it shall come to pass afterward That I will pour out My Spirit on all flesh; Your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, Your old men shall dream dreams, Your young men shall see visions."

In the light of DREAMWEEK being around the corner, Ps Aidan delivered the sermon: Dream Again on Sunday. This was a great reminder to check ourselves and see where we are standing with regards to the dreams God placed in our hearts. This week we are going to recap this sermon in encouragement to place our focus back on our dreams again!

BY LOOKING AT JOEL 2 WE SEE THREE SPECIFIC MANIFESTATIONS OF THE SPIRIT:

1. PEOPLE WILL PROPHESY

WE HAVE THE PROPHETIC WORD!

Ask a homecell member to read 2 Peter 1:19 NKJV and Isaiah 55:11 NKJV

Q: By looking at these verses what do you think is the significance of declaring The Prophetic Word over your dreams?

- We have the prophetic Word at our disposal
- We need to start speaking prophetically into our dreams
- We need to understand the power of our words and that speaking out against our dreams out of frustration or despondency can delay our dreams
- The morning star rising is the manifestation of unseen dreams
- In order for a dream to realize we need to declare the Prophetic Word over our dreams without seize, speaking life into our dreams.



2. PEOPLE WILL SEE VISIONS

HEAVEN IS THE INVISIBLE PLACE OF GOD'S IDEAS THAT HE SENDS TO THE HEARTS OF MEN ON EARTH.

Ask a homecell member to read Acts 9:10-12 NKJV

Q: By looking at this scripture why would you say it is important to write down and act upon the visions entering our minds?

- Answer open for interpretation, but focus should be on Saul staying blind and his Kingdom mission being delayed should Ananias maybe not acted upon the vision he received.

Ask a homecell member to read Habakkuk 2:2-3 NKJV and 2 Corinthians 4:8-9 TPT

According to these two verses we are encouraged to wait upon the fulfilment of a vision and to keep on keeping on!

Q: Why would you say it is important to persist in waiting for it?

- It is important for us to understand a vision is to edify the Kingdom
- At the other side of our obedience lies someone else's salvation or breakthrough.

Q: Why can we keep on keeping on during a season of waiting?

- His Promise stands true
- God promises that the vision is for an appointed time and will come into fulfilment at the right time
- Even though we might get knocked down, He will never forsake us

Q: Have you received a vision or dream that you have forsaken or have not acted upon with the required intentionality?

3. PEOPLE WILL DREAM DREAMS DEAD DREAMS CAN BE RESURRECTED!

Ask a homecell member to read Ezekiel 37:1-10

Q: According to this passage, what do you do, practically, when a dream you have dreamt about has died or is dormant?

- Start prophesying God's Word over your dreams
- Declare the living Word of God over the dry bones (dead dreams)
- Bring your dormant dreams into the presence of God and allow His Revival Fire to resurrect dead dreams into living dreams again.
- Always be obedient to God's command during the season of waiting!

Ask a homecell member to read Mark 9:23 NKJV and Ephesians 3:20 NKJV

In conclusion to resurrecting dormant dreams we must also understand that with obedience, prophesying His living Word and laying down your dreams at His feet, comes belief! We need to stand firm in our conviction that our God CAN do exceedingly, abundantly and above our understanding when we believe!

WORKS

IMPORTANT: Choose one of the four pillars, based on the need of the Homecell, to teach during works. Conclude Homecell with prayer.

1. DISCIPLESHIP

4. PRAYER

Break up in groups of 2-3 and pray over needs identified and pray for world as well.
