WELCOME

Welcome all members who are joining the Homecell online.

WORSHIP

Challenge cell members to spend a few minutes in Worship before your ZOOM/Online Homecell starts. This will create the right atmosphere for your time together.

WORD

In the first week we saw that the enemy is after our belief and last week we saw that if he stops your belief he will stop you from building.

Ask a homecell member to read Is. 49:13 NKJV

- God wants you to build. He does not want you to stay small
- Break out. Be joyful

Ask a homecell member to read Ps. 98:4 TPT

- God is calling many to break out of the box and let loose the God given potential inside of them
- As long as there is limitations you cannot build

Ask a homecell member to read Acts 16:26 TPT

- God call Paul to be a builder of the church and the limitation of imprisonment did not stop God – God says I need Paul to break out
- We must declare prison doors of confinement and chains of bondage to be broker off in Jesus Name

Q: What prison doors need to flung open and chains of captivity need to be broken so you can break out and possess your freedom?

Ask a homecell member to read Luke 4:18-19 TPT

- God anoints you to send the message to those that are not free
- You are accepted by God – do not limit yourself
You can do all things because Christ lives in you
God does not want you to be confined – He wants you to build

Ask a few homecell member to read the following:

Luke 1:68 TPT – Christ was sent to set us free

Matt. 8:16 TPT – He wants to deliver us

Mark 5:18 TPT – He sets you free and now you can move on. Unbelief will not grip your heart

Matt. 10:8 TPT – We are called to be free, now you need to free others.

4 Areas God wants us to break out of

1. Break out of lack - Num. 13:27-28a NKJV

- Your mind can be in a place of poverty while you are in abundance
- We need to change our mindset of lack
- As you think so you will be – break out of lack
- There are 2 kinds of lack, your own self-imposed lack and other people's imposed lack on you.

2. Break out of low self-image – Num. 13:28 NKJV and Rom. 8:29-30 TPT

- Man is not born with a self-image but a God image
- We choose to lower our own image when we compare or elevate someone else's image over ours
- God knew you before you were born, who can then tell you what your worth is
- God determine your destiny – man cannot do it
- Love yourself and tell yourself you are great

3. Break out of limitations – Num. 13:31 NKJV and 1 Sam. 17:38-39

- Two kinds of limitations
 - Limitation you place on yourself – walk through the valley of the shadow of death
 - What others place on you
- Change your mind – get out of the place of unbelief
- God will promote you in the place of your gifting

4. Break out of labels that we place on ourselves – Num. 13:33 NKJV

- Have you labelled yourself as a grasshopper?
- What labels did you place upon yourself?
 - **John 1:46 NKJV** – They even labelled Christ
 - **Num. 13:30 NKJV** – Caleb did not accept the limitation. He represents the mindset that my God has no lack
 - **Phil. 4:19 NKJV** – Caleb represents the mindset that says my God is my image and with my God I don't have limitations but walk in limitless potential
 - **Deut. 28:2-9 NKJV** – You will receive everything if you obey the word of God. You will receive all the blessings

WORKS
