WELCOME

Welcome all members who are joining the Homecell.

WORSHIP

Prepare Praise and Worship for the Homecell gathering (1 Praise & 2 Worship songs)

WORD

Ask a few cell members to read Ezekiel 37:1-7; Luke 1:37; Jeremiah 32:17; Isaiah 43:18-19

QUESTION 1: God brought Ezekiel to a place of impossibilities – a valley of dry bones. God asked Ezekiel if the bones can live again. What would you say are some of the seeming impossibilities you're currently facing? What are some of the seeming impossibilities we as a nation are facing? What do you believe? Can these bones live?

I don't say what CNN is saying, I don't say what the nay-sayers are saying, I don't say what the politicians are saying... I say what God says – that I have a great future!

QUESTION 2: What was God's first instruction to Ezekiel, according to Ezekiel 37:4? How does this instruction apply to us today?

Answer: The principle of prophesy and its power as a spiritual weapon is as relevant today as it was when God instructed Ezekiel to do it. We have the ability to speak God's Word into our situation and circumstances. Our prophetic declaration has the power to turn things around!

Take a few minutes to pray over some of the people in your homecell who are facing some difficult circumstances. Prophesy God's Word over their life and situation.

Ask a cell member to read Ezekiel 37:7 again

QUESTION 3: What was the outcome and result of Ezekiel's prophesy? What should we take from this?

*Answer: "...there was a noise, and **SUDDENLY** a rattling..." Suddenly things started to change! We must pray for and expect God to suddenly show up in our situation. Expect a "suddenly-experience" in your situation!*

We have to reposition ourselves and we have to get ready for God's orchestrated suddenlies in our life!
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LET'S HAVE A LOOK AT SOME OF THESE SUDDEN MOMENTS IN THE BIBLE

Ask a few cell members to read these passages:

- Acts 9:1-6: **PAUL ON THE ROAD TO DAMASCUS** - saved suddenly and dramatically; literally from persecuting the church one day to preaching the gospel the next
- Luke 19:5-6, 9: **ZACCHAEUS' SALVATION CAME SUDDENLY**
- Luke 13:11-13: **THE WOMAN WHO WAS BOUND BY THE SPIRIT OF INFIRMITY FOR 18 YEARS** - her freedom came suddenly
- Acts 16:25-26: **PAUL AND SILAS IN PRISON** – their deliverance came suddenly
- Mark 5:2-5: **THE MANIAC OF THE GADARENES** - bound by chains the one moment, clothed and in his right mind the next
- Mark 5:27-29: **THE WOMAN WITH THE ISSUE OF BLOOD FOR 12 YEARS** - her healing came suddenly
- Luke 5:4-6: **PETER WHO TOILING ALL NIGHT CATCHING NOTHING** – the very next morning a huge catch
- 1 Kings 19:5: **ELIJAH IN THE VALLEY OF DISCOURAGEMENT**

QUESTION 4: What do you learn from these examples? How should you adjust your expectation for 2022?

QUESTION 5: Throughout the Bible we see how many people experienced a sudden move of God. How does our expectation and attitude influence these moments?

Answer: Our expectation and anticipation will not have an influence on what God already decided to do but, it will have a definite influence on what we'll experience. Jesus couldn't perform many miracles in His hometown because the people was neutral. On the other hand, a Shunamite woman – whom Jesus said He cannot help – got her child's healing because of her expectation and persistence. We cannot afford to have a neutral attitude!

Ask a few cell members to read Isaiah 59:19b; Zechariah 4:6; Isaiah 60:22

QUESTION 6: What do you hear about your situation and circumstances when you read these scriptures?

This Bible is full of God's unexpected suddenlies. I want you to know, God is no respecter of persons. I believe God has an unexpected suddenly in mind for you!

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WORKS

We only have a few weeks left until the end of this year. Let's do all within our power to get our members back in the presence of God. Invite everyone to Sunday's service!
