WORSHIP

Prepare Praise and Worship for the Homecell gathering (1 Praise & 2 Worship songs)

WORD

Ask a cell member to read Psalm 105:37-41

QUESTION 1: This Psalm is referring to God's faithfulness towards His people as He led them to their promise land. Why would you say is this passage relevant to us living in 2021?

1 Corinthians 10:10-11 Amplified Bible

¹⁰ And do not murmur [in unwarranted discontent], as some of them did—and were destroyed by the destroyer. ¹¹ Now these things happened to them as an example and warning [to us]; they were written for our instruction [to admonish and equip us], upon whom the ends of the ages have come.

QUESTION 2: This Psalm is a testimony of God's faithfulness. In what ways have you experienced God's faithfulness during the course of the past 21 months?

I believe 2022 is going to be a year of breakthrough: a year where you are going to see and experience more of the goodness of God. You need to get ready for it!

Ask a few cell members to read 2 Timothy 2:13; 2 Thessalonians 3:3; Hebrews 10:23; Numbers 23:19; Lamentations 3:22-23; Psalm 91:4; Romans 8:28

QUESTION 3: What do we learn about God's faithfulness portrayed in these scriptures?

Psalm 105:41 New King James Version

He opened the rock, and water gushed out; it ran in the dry places like a river.

Our God will open the rock and the water will GUSH OUT! God is going to touch the barren and dead areas of your life in Jesus Name! Every door that has been closed will be opened. Every mountain will be moved. Those who opposed you, God will use to bless you!

QUESTION 5: God is challenging each and every one of us to ARISE AND SHINE. What does that practically mean to you? How should we ARISE AND SHINE?

Answer: We must understand that God's glory has already risen upon us. It's now our responsibility to arise...

- *with expectation*
- *with anticipation*
- *with a positive attitude*
- *in faith*
- *in being proactive*

Ask a few cell members to read Jeremiah 32:27 & Genesis 18:10-13

QUESTION 6: What is the lesson we learn from these passages and how is this relevant to us?

Answer: There is nothing too difficult for God. Be patient. God knows what He's doing! You may be facing a dead end right now — financial, emotional, or relational — but if you will trust God and keep on moving in faith, even when you don't see a way out, He will make a way.

Ask a cell member to read Ezekiel 47:1-12

There is a move of God about to break loose such as the world has not witnessed. He is going to sweep through cities and nations. It is time to draw near to Him!

QUESTION 7: What does Ezekiel 47:1-12 symbolize? How should we prepare ourselves for the move of God?

Answer: Ezekiel 47:1-12 symbolizes the presence and anointing of God moving from the church. It will bring life to everything it comes in contact with. We should prepare ourselves for a massive move of God by:

- *pressing in and praying like never;*
- *going after the lost with a renewed passion;*
- *keeping the voice of rejoicing at an all-time high.*
