## **John 8:36 NKJV**

*"Therefore if the Son makes you free, you shall be free indeed.."*

This Sunday Ps Aidan delivered the sermon: Free To Be. This week we will recap the sermon and understand that "If I want to be free, I have to be me!"

### **Ask a homecell member to read John 8:36 NKJV**

**If I want to be free, I've got to be me. Not the me you think I should be. Not the me my wife or husband or friends thinks me to be. Not the me my kids or family think I should be but the me God created me to be.**

### **Ask a homecell member to read Luke 4:18-19 TPT**

**God has to make us free in order for us to be everything He created us to be.**

**Q: By looking at this verse why would you say it is important for us to be made free?**

- Once we are free, we can be the light, salt and hope to the world.
- In freedom we proclaim freedom to those in captive
- We can spread the gospel like we were called to

**Q: By looking at verse 19 specifically, why can you say we can stand boldly in our trust within God?**

- Christ accepts us for ALL that we are
- He never changes and therefore we can put our hope and trust within Him
- His acceptance surpasses other's opinions.



**Ask a homecell member to read Psalm 23:4 NKJV**

Often people fall in fear and live in the shadows, according to this verse we understand that God is ALWAYS with you to comfort you.

**Q: What is something that currently steals your freedom from you? What is something that forces you to live in fear and stay in the valley rather than experiencing God's freedom?**

(Rhetorical question)

**Ask a homecell members to read John 8:36 NKJV and Matthew 4:19 NKJV**

According to these two verses we can clearly see that God's call to freedom is **MAKE ME FREE**, while the worlds call to freedom is give me freedom.

**Q: According to the verses how are we able to obtain freedom?**

- We must believe and receive freedom through our faith.
- Once you've accepted freedom you need to allow God to take you through the process of becoming all He created you to be.

*It's often in the quest of what we think we need to do to gain freedom that actually binds us by the wrong freedom. In the next section we will look at the story of the Prodigal son as a representation of this.*

**Ask a homecell member to read Luke 15:11-15 NKJV**

According to this passage we are able to see the difference of what the wrong freedom and what Godly freedom looks like.

**Worldly Freedom**

- Premature demands on life
- Taking, getting and receiving
- Life separated from your Father
- Life outside of The Father's house
- Ultimately is bondage

vs.

**Godly Freedom**

- Receiving according to God's timing
- Earning, giving and sharing
- Life close to your Father
- Life within The Father's house
- Ultimately is Freedom

**Q: Which freedom would you say are you busy pursuing?**

**Ask a homecell member to read Luke 15:16-19 NKJV**

**Q: According to these verses should we have pursued wordly freedom how do we pursue Godly freedom again?**

- Choose to come back
- Repent from your wrongdoing
- Allow Him to take you through the process of becoming
- The body decerns, come back to His house and stay active in His house
- Submit as a servant within His House

**WE CAN NO LONGER HAVE THE MINDSET OF WHAT I CAN GET FROM MY FATHER BUT WHAT MY FATHER CAN ACCOMPLISH THROUGH ME.**

## WORKS

### 1. DISCIPLESHIP
