STEP OUT ON THE PROMISES OF GOD

31 OCTOBER 2021

WELCOME

Welcome all members who are joining the Homecell.

WORSHIP

Prepare Praise and Worship for the Homecell gathering (1 Praise & 2 Worship songs).

WORD

Hebrews 11:8 TPT

"Faith motivated Abraham to obey God's call and leave the familiar to discover the territory he was destined to inherit from God. So he left with only a promise and without even knowing ahead of time where he was going, Abraham stepped out in faith."

Question 1: Here we read that Abraham stepped out on "only" a promise from God. What fears have prevented you from stepping out before?

Ask a few cell members to read Romans 8:18-19 and Jeremiah 29:11

God has a great plan for each one of us. That plan is a promise. In order to get there, we have to step there! In order to fulfil the plan, we need to walk out the plan.

Question 2: According to Hebrews 11, what does stepping out on the promises of God require of us?

Faith! "Faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things unseen".

Question 3: Can you think of someone in your life whose faith has inspired you?

Ask a cell member to read Judges 6:11-16

Question 4: How does Gideon's response represent how many people respond to God's call today?

Many are comfortable with the familiar. That's what fear does, it makes you hide and play it safe. Gideon was walking by sight and not by faith. But the Bible tells us we must walk by faith, not sight (**2 Corinthians 5:7**)

Question 5: What does God talk to Gideon about instead?

God does not speak to him about the size of his problem but the size of his promise. Gideon keeps looking to his past and his present, God speaks to his future.

Ask a few cell members to read Judges 6:17, Matthew 12:38-39 and Hebrews 12:2

Question 6: Many people are looking for a sign before they step out. According to Hebrews, what should we be looking to instead?

We are not called to look for signs but to look to the Son. If Christ authored your life plan, the Bible says He also finishes it.

God wants to reveal his promises and his plans to you! There is territory that is part of your inheritance that is still to be possessed!

Step out on the promises of God – by faith!

WORKS

Choose one of the four pillars, based on the need of the Homecell, to teach during works. Please see to it that teachings address the lack of the Homecell. Conclude Homecell with prayer.

1. DISCIPLESHIP
