## YOU WILL RECEIVE POWER (Part 1)

23 JANUARY 2022

### WELCOME

Welcome all members who are joining the Homecell whether online or physical. If HC is on Zoom only - do an Icebreaker on WhatsApp ± 15 minutes before Zoom cell. If HC is physical – do an Icebreaker for approx. 10 minutes at start of HC.

### WORSHIP

If HC is physical -1 Praise & 2 Worship. This will create the right atmosphere for your time together. End Worship 2 in prayer.

If ZOOM only - Challenge cell members to spend a few minutes in Worship before your ZOOM/Online Homecell starts.

### WORD

**The Bible says in Acts 1:8 (NLT) “But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you” Last Sunday we looked at the good work that God began in you. What is that good work that He begins in us?**

A: You will receive power through the Holy Spirit and the good work that is produced in us is through the power of the Holy Spirit. We as Christians have the unfair advantage of the infusion or infilling of the Power of the Holy Spirit.

**Q: Matthew 6:9-10 (NKJV) teaches us to pray “Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven”. What does it mean of us as a homecell? (A few members can share)**

A: God's power is there for each one of us and you cannot separate God and His power in heaven from God's manifestation of that power on earth. This power can be received by each one of us for the purpose of manifesting God's power, will and blessing on earth. Yet sometimes we are loadshedding this faith which delays God's breakthrough or manifestation on earth in our lives. If this happens, we have to make things happen instead of letting things happen. If we therefore want to experience the breakthrough of God, this year we would be wise to use the power given to us by God and not try to grind out breakthrough in our own human strength.

The Greek word for power is “Dunamis”. During this series Ps Aidan is going to focus on:

1. Strength power ... and enabling power
2. Inherent power, power residing in a thing by virtue of its nature, or which a person or thing exerts and puts forth power for performing miracles
3. Moral power and excellence of soul
4. The power and influence which belongs to riches and wealth
5. Power and resources arising from numbers
6. Power consisting of in or resting upon armies, forces, hosts

## This week we will focus on

### 1. Enabling power

**Ask a homecell member to read Phil. 4:13, Eph. 3:20-21 (NKJV)**

**Q: What do these scriptures show us about Christ and what He wants to give His Church?**

A: Without being connected to the source of power we end up trying to make things happen instead of letting things happen.

- So many Christians are trying to do things for God but they have loadshedded their faith
- We know when the power is not working, we are not able to do much
- When we understand the source of our power, we are not supposed to be doing but being an available conduit for God's power to flow and work through us.

### 2. It's an inherent power

It's a power residing in a thing by virtue of its nature, or which a person or thing exerts and puts forth power for performing miracles

**Q: How do you overcome the forces of evil and darkness?**

A: We received God's power to overcome, and we must have faith to let this power work in our lives. This power is not our own but God's power in us to overcome anything coming our way. It is time to get back to the grid of God's power.

**Ask a homecell member to read John 16:24 and Luke 11:13 NKJV**

**Q: As a homecell what can we do in 2022 to ensure that God's power work through us?**

A:

- At the end of God's power there will always be a manifested result or breakthrough so we must purposefully start to increase our oikos and build relationship with the unchurched and invite them to church
- We can be faithful in our tithing
- We can ask to stay plugged into the power of God
- We can have a servant heart

## WORKS

1. **PRAYER** - Take time to pray for (1) lost & prodigals on your prayer or target lists (2) One another (lay hands 1-1 or groups of 2-3)
2. **CARE** - As a HC, identify urgent needs (among people in your immediate world) - food needs, people who are staying alone, marriage challenges, financial needs, business, career, employment needs, emotional needs etc.). How can we meet those needs?
3. **DISCIPLESHIP** - Equip HC in Basic Doctrine (Water Baptism, Tongues, Serving, Giving, Honour, Vision)
4. **EVANGELISM** - Equip HC in reaching their world (Build relationship with Oikos, Identify Man Of Peace, Share Your Verbal Witness, Invite To Church & HC)
