WORD

QUESTION 1: What would you say is your most prized possession you currently own? What do you physically do to insure, protect and secure this possession?

QUESTION 2: If you need to be brutally honest with yourself, where does your faith rank on your list of most prized possessions?

Ask a cell member to read Matthew 13:44

QUESTION 3: Why should our faith (*our love for God and His kingdom purpose*) be the most prized possession in our life?

The one thing you never want to compromise on is your faith, because it has eternal consequences. The one thing you want to leave as a rich inheritance for your children... is way more than silver and gold... it is your faith!

1 Peter 1:7 The Living Bible

These trials are only to test your faith, to see whether or not it is strong and pure. It is being tested as fire tests gold and purifies it—and your faith is far more precious to God than mere gold; so if your faith remains strong after being tried in the test tube of fiery trials, it will bring you much praise and glory and honor on the day of his return.

QUESTION 4: According to the Apostle Peter, what's God's perspective on our faith?

Answer: The Apostle Peter says that, in God's eyes, our faith is more precious than gold. In the context Peter is writing, gold was by far the most valuable thing a person could possess. In today's context it means that God perceives your faith more important than the most sought-after thing on this planet.

Ask a few cell members to read Matthew 16:18 & 24; 2 Corinthians 5:10; 1 John 2:15-17; Ecclesiastes 12:6-8, 13-14

QUESTION 5: What would you say is the key principle we can take from these scriptures?

Answer: Whether you believe it or not, we will all one day appear before the judgement seat of Christ. On that day your title, personal accomplishments, bank balance and possessions will have no value. All that will be considered will be your relationship with God. For this reason, this should be something we respect, preserve and protect more than anything else in our life.

2. YOUR FAITH IS SOMETHING YOU HAVE TO PASS ON

Ask a few cell members to read Proverbs 13:22a; Proverbs 22:6; Deuteronomy 6:4-9; Joshua 24:15

QUESTION 6: What can you practically do to ensure that you pass your faith on to your children?

QUESTION 7: Why would you say is 'setting the right example' such a powerful tool when it comes to instilling our faith into our children?
