## PROSPEROUS ETERNITY

### WELCOME

Welcome all members who are joining the Homecell whether online or physical.  
If HC is on Zoom only – do an Icebreaker on WhatsApp ± 15 minutes before Zoomcell.  
If HC is physical – do an Icebreaker for approx. 10 minutes at start of HC.

### WORSHIP

If HC is physical -1 Praise & 2 Worship. This will create the right atmosphere for your time together. End Worship 2 in prayer.  
If Zoom only - Challenge cell members to spend a few minutes in Worship before your ZOOM/Online Homecell starts.

### WORD

#### **Ephesians 3:20 NKJV**

*"Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me. [2] In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. [3] And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also. [4] And where I go you know, and the way you know."*

#### **Ask a few cell members to read John 3:3, John 14:6 and Romans 10:13**

**Q: Share your personal salvation experience (allow one or two members to share)**

It's the person of Jesus that prepares us for eternity! It's the decision to place your faith and belief in the shed blood of Jesus and by confessing Him as Lord that saves us from ourselves and prospers us for eternity.

#### **Ask a few cell members to read John 3:16; John 15:3 and 1 Peter 1:17-20 NLT**

**Q: Jesus became the most precious seed ever sown when He paid for your and my sins with His own blood. When we receive Jesus into our hearts we never die, but simply transition from our earthly lives into our eternal lives. How should this inspire us to live our lives here on earth?**

It does not matter how much money you end up having or how much earthly stuff you build up by applying Jesus' principles on earth, the reality is we can take nothing with us into eternity except souls!

### Ask a cell member to read John 14:2

#### Q: What does this Scripture tell us about heaven and where we will spend eternity?

- Heaven is a prosperous place!
- The dictionary describes the word "Mansion" as a large and impressive house" as well as "A place where someone stays"
- The place Jesus prepares for those who have received Him into their lives is not a small, unimpressive pokey little place. It is a large, impressive, expansive, beautiful, magnificent and eternal place where we will live with Him for eternity.

### Ask a few cell members to read Matthew 16:19-20 and Philippians 1:21-23

#### Q: What eternity-minded principles do you derive from these scriptures?

- Though we are born to prosper here on earth, the places we build and live in are temporary. We can take nothing with us to heaven except souls!
- We should not serve money, money should serve us. How? By giving it away! Every time we sow into the Kingdom, we are sowing into eternity
- We should live with eternity in mind, using our resources and dominion for the right purpose

### Ask a few cell members to read these Scriptures:

Heaven is:

1. A happy place (**Hebrews 12:22-23**)
2. A permanent place of worship (**Revelation 7:9-10**)
3. A place of peace and provision (**Revelation 7:15-16**)
4. A place of indescribable beauty (**Revelation 21:9-11**)
5. A place of pearl gates and streets of gold (**Revelation 21:21**)
6. A place of abundant fruitfulness and healing (**Revelation 22:2**)
7. A place of permanent light and glory (**Revelation 22:4-5**)

#### Q: How can we create "heaven on earth" in our homecell?

A: [Anything in line with]

- Sharing the good news of the gospel
- Bearing the fruit of the Spirit – love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control
- Serving in the house with excellence
- Tithes and offerings – being generous with our resources
- Having dominion over the places God has given us – enlarging our territory

## WORKS

(1) PRAYER - Take time to pray for (1) Lost & prodigals on Your Prayer/Target lists (2) One another (lay hands 1-1/groups of 2-3)

(2) CARE - As a HC, identify urgent needs (among people in your immediate world) - food needs, people who are staying alone, marriage challenges, financial needs, business/career/employment needs, emotional needs etc.). How can we meet those needs?

(3) DISCIPLESHIP - Equip HC in Basic Doctrine (Water Baptism /Tongues /Serving /Giving /Honour /Vision)

(4) EVANGELISM - Equip HC in Reaching Their World (Build Relationship With Oikos/Identify Man Of Peace/Share Your Verbal Witness/Invite To Church & HC)
