WELCOME

Welcome all members who are joining the Homecell whether online or physical.
If HC is on Zoom only - do an Icebreaker on WhatsApp ± 15 minutes before Zoom cell.
If HC is physical – do an Icebreaker for approx. 10 minutes at start of HC.

WORSHIP

If HC is physical -1 Praise & 2 Worship. This will create the right atmosphere for your time together. End Worship 2 in prayer.

If ZOOM only - Challenge cell members to spend a few minutes in Worship before your ZOOM/Online Homecell starts.

WORD

Isaiah 40:13 NKJV But those who wait on the LORD Shall renew their strength; They shall mount up with wings like eagles, They shall run and not be weary, They shall walk and not faint.

Q: According to Is. 40:13 what did Isaiah prophesied for those who wait and walk with God?

- A:
- They will run and win.
 - We need an energy source and continual spiritual boost in order to not grow weary
 - It is in the journey of serving the Lord that we renew our strength

Q: How can we as a homecell renew our strength according to Eccl. 4:12 and Jer. 17:7-8 NLT?

- A:
- When we “bind ourselves together” we become intertwined with the Lord and an intertwined life with God and His Son, and His Word and His Spirit are not easily broken or defeated.
 - If we therefore wait upon the Lord our strength will be renewed

Ask a homecell member to read Isaiah 40:31 (TPT) and Acts 2:1-2 (MSG)

Q: What else will happen to us when we wait upon the Lord?

- A:
- They will rise up on soaring wings and fly like eagles
 - If we therefore want a winner’s mindset it will require us to have an eagle perspective and not a chicken perspective
 - In order to fly you will need wind to push you up and the Holy Spirit is the wind to push you to rise and fly like an eagle

Q: When we wait on the Lord, we run life's race without growing weary. What does God promise in His word according to Ps.16:1-2,18:30and 22:27-28 (MSG)?

- The Lord will keep me safe and without Him, nothing makes sense
- Every God-direction is road tested and we will make it if we wait on Him
- People will come to their senses and run back to God

Q: When we wait on the Lord, how do we walk through life according to Ps. 23:1-6 (MSG)?

A:

- Because God is our Shepherd, we won't need anything
- We are bedded down in lush meadows and will have quiet pools to drink from.
- We will be directed by God even when we go through death's valley
- Because God walk at my side, I will not be afraid
- Because God is my Shepherd, I will feel secure, and His love will chase after me every day of my life.

WORKS

1. **PRAYER** - Take time to pray for (1) lost & prodigals on your prayer or target lists (2) One another (lay hands 1-1 or groups of 2-3)
2. **CARE** - As a HC, identify urgent needs (among people in your immediate world) - food needs, people who are staying alone, marriage challenges, financial needs, business, career, employment needs, emotional needs etc.). How can we meet those needs?
3. **DISCIPLESHIP** - Equip HC in Basic Doctrine (Water Baptism, Tongues, Serving, Giving, Honour, Vision)
4. **EVANGELISM** - Equip HC in reaching their world (Build relationship with Oikos, Identify Man of Peace, Share Your Verbal Witness, Invite to Church & HC)
