AGGRESSIVELY ADVANCE AND EXPAND (Part 2)

WELCOME

Welcome all members who are joining the Homecell whether online or physical.
If HC is on Zoom only - do an Icebreaker on WhatsApp ± 15 minutes before Zoom cell.
If HC is physical – do an Icebreaker for approx. 10 minutes at start of HC.

WORSHIP

If HC is physical -1 Praise & 2 Worship. This will create the right atmosphere for your time together. End Worship 2 in prayer.

If ZOOM only - Challenge cell members to spend a few minutes in Worship before your ZOOM/Online Homecell starts.

WORD

It is time for every believer to get back and get busy intentionally, noticeably, aggressively, advancing and expanding God's kingdom together

Ask a homecell member to read Matt. 11:12 (NKJV)

Q: From this reading what action or force must we apply?

- We need to apply Spiritual force and aggression and start praying
- We need to walk in the authority of God
- Something has to break in order for change to come
- We need to become intentional and deliberately decide to do something about the current state of affairs in your life

Q: What causes a person who is full of God's potential, energy, and vision to become stagnant or passive or evasive about their lives and future?

- If you only live for comfort it is a curse
- Comfort can make you think that contribution and commitment is the same thing
- You need to press in and declare God's word over every area of your life
- Fear will cause you to believe the opposite to what God's word and promises says about your life.
- Faith comes through God's word and God can only give you a promise if you read His word
- We must learn how to be patient within the process

Ask a homecell member to read Heb. 11:6 (NKJV)

Q: What is impossible without faith from this scripture verse?

1. To please God

- It is impossible to please God without faith
 - You need to be a faithful servant
 - Fear will rob you of your God potential
2. To come to God
 - When we listen to the word of God then faith comes
 - Come to God in prayer and worship
 3. To believe God
 - We can only come to God when we believe
 4. To receive from God
 - It is impossible to receive from God if we do not believe
 - If we walk in unbelief God can do nothing for us
 5. To remain diligent
 - God is a good God when you diligently seek Him

Ask a homecell member to read Heb. 11:1 (TPT)

Q: How do we as a homecell come back to a place of faith?

[Allow several people to share.]

- We must choose to act and not camp
- We must realise that we have a free will to choose
- We must decide to not speak death but to always speak life
- We must walk in faith daily and not in death

Ask a homecell member to read Heb. 11:4(a), 11:7(a), 11:8, 11:11 and 11:30 (TPT)

Q From these verses what did faith allowed biblical greats to do?

- It moved Abel to choose a more acceptable sacrifice to offer God than his brother Cain
- It opened Noah's heart to received revelation and warnings from God about what was coming, even things never seen
- Faith motivated Abraham to obey God's call even if there was only a promise
- Sarah's faith embraced the miracle power to conceive even though she was barren and past the age of childbearing
- Faith pulled down Jericho's walls

WORKS

1. **PRAYER** - Take time to pray for (1) lost & prodigals on your prayer or target lists (2) One another (lay hands 1-1 or groups of 2-3)
2. **CARE** - As a HC, identify urgent needs (among people in your immediate world) - food needs, people who are staying alone, marriage challenges, financial needs, business, career, employment needs, emotional needs etc.). How can we meet those needs?
3. **DISCIPLESHIP** - Equip HC in Basic Doctrine (Water Baptism, Tongues, Serving, Giving, Honour, Vision)
4. **EVANGELISM** - Equip HC in reaching their world (Build relationship with Oikos, Identify Man of Peace, Share Your Verbal Witness, Invite to Church & HC)
