WELCOME

Welcome all members who are joining the Homecell whether online or physical.
If HC is on Zoom only - do an Icebreaker on WhatsApp ± 15 minutes before Zoom cell.
If HC is physical – do an Icebreaker for approx. 10 minutes at start of HC.

WORSHIP

If HC is physical -1 Praise & 2 Worship. This will create the right atmosphere for your time together. End Worship 2 in prayer.

If ZOOM only - Challenge cell members to spend a few minutes in Worship before your ZOOM/Online Homecell starts.

WORD

Matthew 17:1-8 *"This is my dearly loved Son, who brings me great joy. Listen to him."*

Q: What distractions keeps us from the will or plan of God for us?

[Allow several people to share.]

- We must keep our focus on Jesus and His word only.
- We need to make sure that we do not camp and make memorials of things that happened in the past
- Jesus is the Lord over all and His will for all of mankind is to get up and see only see Jesus as the answer to life and eternity
- The enemy wants you to settle for alternative options in your live instead of the ultimate plan and will of God for your life.

Q: What was the statement that Peter makes that caused him to be corrected by God?

[Allow several people to share.]

- That he wanted to make three memorials
- So often when we get knocked down or go through storms or when we experience a glimpse of God's goodness, we want to build memorials there.

Ask a homecell member to read Matt. 17:5 (NLT)

Q: What was response from God?

[Allow several people to share.]

- NKJV says "This is My Son, hear Him"

- God has not destined your life or your designed plan for your life to be determined or told by others
- We must be a Bible reading church and His word must be first in our lives
- We must listen to God and His word and break down the memorials build
- We need to get up and only see Jesus and do not allow alternatives of the enemies lies

There was two alternatives Peter placed before Jesus:

Ask a homecell member to read Heb. 3:5-6 (NLT), Rom. 8:3-4 (TPT), Matt. 11:28-30 (MSG) and Heb. 1:1-3 (TPT)

Q: From this scripture verses what teaching are there from Moses (the law), Elijah (the prophetic) and Jesus (our Lord and Saviour) for us as homecell?

[Allow several people to share.]

- Moses was faithful in God's house, but Jesus is Lord over God's house. We need to be faithful in God's house, but Jesus oversees the house
- Jesus is not one among equals but Lord over all and who the Son set free is free indeed
- He is our advocate and when we repent the Holy Spirit will take that repentance to Jesus who will be our advocate before God the Father
- Keep company with Jesus and you will be free
- Because of Jesus God speaks to us openly and I can believe what I speak through the word "I am the head and not the tail"

Ask a homecell member to read John 8:7-11 (TPT)

Q What do you learn about the character of Jesus from these verses

- Our hope is in Jesus Christ. He is steadfast and faithful
- God is the one that strengthens us for what we are going through
- God will give you wisdom to get out of your situation no matter what
- If we keep our eyes on Jesus daily and stand on His word, we are free to life a life free from sin

WORKS

1. **PRAYER** - Take time to pray for (1) lost & prodigals on your prayer or target lists (2) One another (lay hands 1-1 or groups of 2-3)
2. **CARE** - As a HC, identify urgent needs (among people in your immediate world) - food needs, people who are staying alone, marriage challenges, financial needs, business, career, employment needs, emotional needs etc.). How can we meet those needs?
3. **DISCIPLESHIP** - Equip HC in Basic Doctrine (Water Baptism, Tongues, Serving, Giving, Honour, Vision)
4. **EVANGELISM** - Equip HC in reaching their world (Build relationship with Oikos, Identify Man of Peace, Share Your Verbal Witness, Invite to Church & HC)
