## GET UP TO GET ON (Part 1)

31 JULY 2022

### WELCOME

Welcome all members who are joining the Homecell whether online or physical.  
If HC is on Zoom only - do an Icebreaker on WhatsApp ± 15 minutes before Zoom cell.  
If HC is physical – do an Icebreaker for approx. 10 minutes at start of HC.

### WORSHIP

If HC is physical -1 Praise & 2 Worship. This will create the right atmosphere for your time together. End Worship 2 in prayer.

If ZOOM only - Challenge cell members to spend a few minutes in Worship before your ZOOM/Online Homecell starts.

### WORD

**John 5:1-9 AMP** *Jesus said to him, "Get up; pick up your pallet and walk."*

**Q: What does this scripture says about your validity?**

[Allow several people to share.]

- We are not invalid, and it is time to get up and get on with it
- A mistake does not make you invalid but the enemy wants you to believe that when you get knocked down you have to stay down
- Jesus came to give us life and give it more abundantly
- It is only the ticket in your had that it invalid, and not you
- Call out to God and He will allow you to get on with it
- Because of Jesus your life counts for something

**Q: Why does the enemy tries to convince us that we are unable to recover?**

[Allow several people to share.]

- So that you can remain in the same place of frustration, limitation, and procrastination.

**Ask a homecell member to read John 5:5-7 (NLT)**

**Q: What was the response of the sick man when Jesus asked him if I want to get well?**

[Allow several people to share.]

- His first reaction was that "he can't"
- He felt invalid and not recognised.
- Someone always gets there ahead of him

**Ask a homecell member to read John 9:1-3 (NLT)**

**Q: If we are going through battles or sins, is God punishing us?**

[Allow several people to share.]

- God is not punishing you when you sin as He took all sin on Him on the cross
- God is not withholding things from you
- God is using you to glorify Him and want to demonstrate His power through your life as it will become your testimony.
- You need to know the word of God so that you are not swayed by anything

**Ask a homecell member to read John 9:4-5 (NLT)**

**Q: From this scripture what are we as homecell called to do?**

[Allow several people to share.]

- We must quickly do the work that is assigned to us. We cannot camp.
- We must get busy going to those who have been knocked down by life's challenges
- We must go to those who lost their vision and remind them that God hasn't written them off, so they must never write themselves off
- We can go through suffering because the Greater One lives inside of us

**Ask a homecell member to read 2 Cor. 4:13-16 (NLT)**

**Q: Ask yourself what to do when you don't know what to do?**

- We continue to be the light to the world no matter what we are going through
- God will give you wisdom to get out of your situation no matter what
- God will raise you up
- God uses your suffering for the benefit of people around you – let me tell you “My God”
- Look onto Jesus daily and renew your spirit every day
- It is not how we start but it is how we finish

## WORKS

1. **PRAYER** - Take time to pray for (1) lost & prodigals on your prayer or target lists (2) One another (lay hands 1-1 or groups of 2-3)
2. **CARE** - As a HC, identify urgent needs (among people in your immediate world) - food needs, people who are staying alone, marriage challenges, financial needs, business, career, employment needs, emotional needs etc.). How can we meet those needs?
3. **DISCIPLESHIP** - Equip HC in Basic Doctrine (Water Baptism, Tongues, Serving, Giving, Honour, Vision)
4. **EVANGELISM** - Equip HC in reaching their world (Build relationship with Oikos, Identify Man of Peace, Share Your Verbal Witness, Invite to Church & HC)
