WORSHIP

Prepare Praise and Worship for the Homecell gathering (1 Praise & 2 Worship songs)

WORD

Ask a few cell members to read John 16:7, 12-13; Romans 8:14; Isaiah 48:17

QUESTION 1: The past few weeks we've been talking about making God-guided decisions by faith. In line with this, what can we learn from these verses?

*Answer: 1. It is God's desire to reveal the future to His children
2. God does not want us to live a guessing life or stumbling through life as those who are blind in the darkness
3. As your Father He wants to guide you into the detailed plans He has for your life*

QUESTION 2: What role does the Holy Spirit play in this guiding process?

Answer: Jesus promised that we'll not be alone in this process. The Holy Spirit will lead and guide us into all truth... that means the Holy Spirit is our personal guide. He's with you 24/7 and He desires to lead you into all truth.

QUESTION 3: In what ways have you experienced the Holy Spirit leading you in the past?

On Sunday Pastor At shared with us the 3 main ways through which the Holy Spirit will lead and guide us. Let's have a look at each one of them:

In every major destiny and big kingdom decision in my life I have followed all three witnesses in agreement!!! Not one or two, but all three.

1. THE WORD OF GOD – THE IS THE RULE NOT THE EXCEPTION

2 Timothy 3:16 Amplified Bible

All Scripture is God-breathed [given by divine inspiration] and is profitable for instruction, for conviction [of sin], for correction [of error and restoration to obedience], for training in righteousness [learning to live in conformity to God's will, both publicly and privately—behaving honorably with personal integrity and moral courage] ...

QUESTION 4: Why should the Word of God play such a prominent role in our lives as children of God?

Answer: God speaks to us through His Word. His Word is His thoughts on paper. As we read the Word, we become acquainted with the ways of God. The Word of God becomes our point of reference.

QUESTION 5: On a practical note: say you need to make a decision and you feel to do or go in a given direction. How would you apply the principle, of allowing the Word to guide you, in this situation?

Answer: The following is important:

- *Make sure you have a clear Word from God – confirmation in the Word of God*
- *When we make a decision ... we submit what we feel to scripture!*
- *Does what I feel to do, violate the principles in the Word – a Word from God will never contradict or violate the Word of God*

2. THE SECOND WITNESS YOU NEED IS: INNER PEACE OR AN INNER WITNESS

Colossians 3:15 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition

And let the peace (soul harmony which comes) from Christ rule (act as umpire continually) in your hearts [deciding and settling with finality all questions that arise in your minds, in that peaceful state] to which as [members of Christ's] one body you were also called [to live].

Ask a cell member to read Acts 16:6-10

QUESTION 6: In line with having inner peace or an inner witness, what can we learn from this passage?

3. THE THIRD WITNESS YOU NEED IN MAKING MAJOR DECISIONS: GODLY COUNSEL

Godly counsel is maybe the most neglected and misunderstood by believers! Godly counsel is not there for control but for protection. Notice I say: Godly counsel, not just any counsel.

Ask a few cell members to read Hebrews 13:17; Proverbs 1:5; Proverbs 15:22; Proverbs 11:14; Proverbs 20:18; Proverbs 24:6; Proverbs 18:1
