WELCOME

Welcome all members who are joining the Homecell whether online or physical.
If HC is on Zoom only – do an Icebreaker on WhatsApp ± 15 minutes before Zoomcell.
If HC is physical – do an Icebreaker for approx. 10 minutes at start of HC.

WORSHIP

If HC is physical -1 Praise & 2 Worship. This will create the right atmosphere for your time together. End Worship 2 in prayer.
If Zoom only - Challenge cell members to spend a few minutes in Worship before your ZOOM/Online Homecell starts.

WORD

Genesis 1:28 AMPC

"And God blessed them and said to them, Be fruitful, multiply, and fill the earth, and subdue it [using all its vast resources in the service of God and man]; and have dominion over the fish of the sea, the birds of the air, and over every living creature that moves upon the earth."

God's plan for man is Destination Dominion both on earth and in heaven. Dominion on earth is gained through the principles of Jesus. Dominion in heaven is gained through the person of Jesus.

Q: How would you define "dominion"?

Dominion means

- to tread down
- to subdue – to bring under full control
- to prevail against
- to reign over

Ask a few cell members to read Mark 8:36 and Matthew 6:33.

Q: What does the upside-down nature of God's kingdom in these passages teach us about Destination Dominion?

- Destination dominion is not about gaining or owning the most possessions
- God blesses us with possessions for a kingdom purpose
- The enemy wants to shift man's focus from purpose to possession
- Focusing on possession causes many to feel inadequate, inferior, unfulfilled and uncertain
- Possession is seeking first the resource for life. Purpose is seeking first the Source of life (God)

"Christianity without purpose does not exist." – Ps Aidan Jeffery

Ask a cell member to read Genesis 3:1-6

Q: The enemy got Eve to focus on the fruit instead of the seed. What does this look like in our daily lives? Can you give an example of when you avoided the process of planting a seed?

- The speed and time of planting a seed, going through a process, being patient in the process are all aspects man tries to avoid
- Compare playing the lottery to building a life of purpose over 50/60/70 years – most people want to do minimum effort for maximum pay-out, take what belongs to another, steal rather than be faithful
- You can't bypass the processes of God!

Ask a few cell members to read Luke 18:18-23

Q: What does this story teach us about the condition of our heart towards our possessions? How can we guard our hearts against this?

- By continuously pursuing the person and purpose of Jesus Christ we will be less tempted to pursue possessions

Q: Our greatest purpose is to win the lost. Think about what this means for you personally. How can you pursue the dreams God has given you with a purpose mindset?

- Encourage homecell members to invite their world to Harvest 2022 (registration is essential)
- Spend some time praying over every invite
- Share on social media!

WORKS

(1) PRAYER - Take time to pray for (1) Lost & prodigals on Your Prayer/Target lists (2) One another (lay hands 1-1/groups of 2-3)

(2) CARE - As a HC, identify urgent needs (among people in your immediate world) - food needs, people who are staying alone, marriage challenges, financial needs, business/career/employment needs, emotional needs etc.). How can we meet those needs?

(3) DISCIPLESHIP - Equip HC in Basic Doctrine (Water Baptism /Tongues /Serving /Giving /Honour /Vision)

(4) EVANGELISM - Equip HC in Reaching Their World (Build Relationship With Oikos/Identify Man Of Peace/Share Your Verbal Witness/Invite To Church & HC)
