WORD

Amos 9:13-15 The Message

“Yes indeed, it won’t be long now.” God’s Decree. “Things are going to happen so fast your head will swim, one thing fast on the heels of the other. You won’t be able to keep up. Everything will be happening at once—and everywhere you look, blessings! Blessings like wine pouring off the mountains and hills. I’ll make everything right again for my people Israel: “They’ll rebuild their ruined cities. They’ll plant vineyards and drink good wine. They’ll work their gardens and eat fresh vegetables. And I’ll plant them, plant them on their own land. They’ll never again be uprooted from the land I’ve given them.” God, your God, says so.

**I declare supernatural acceleration in every area of your life, in Jesus’ name!
I believe we need to prepare for divine acceleration and suddenlies in our lives.**

Ps At Boshoff

Ask a cell member to read Malachi 3:1 & Acts 2:1-4

QUESTION 1: Both these passages, in line with Amos 9, communicate how God often work. What do you identify from these scriptures about how God works?

Answer: Our God is a God of suddenlies. In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye everything can change! Revival... suddenly! A breakthrough... suddenly! The manifestation of your healing... suddenly!

QUESTION 2: How would you define a “sudden” moment?

Answer: According to the Webster’s dictionary a “suddenly” is defined as: 1. something happening unexpectedly; 2. Something changing angle all at once; 3. Something marked by abruptness; or something brought about in a short time.

Ask a few cell members to share a testimony of how God suddenly worked in their life or situation.

Ask a cell member to read Acts 2:1-4 again

QUESTION 3: Acts 2 is a classic example of God working suddenly. What change did this sudden action by God bring about in the lives of the disciples? What can we expect to happen in our own personal lives when God suddenly works?

Answer: In one moment everything changed in their lives forever!! From fearful, timid men, to bold unstoppable world changers and history makers. All because God whom they were seeking, came suddenly!!

QUESTION 4: What other examples in the Bible can you recall where God moved swiftly and suddenly?

Let's have a closer look at some of these examples:

- **THE APOSTLE PAUL** (*Ask a cell member to read Acts 9:1-6*)

QUESTION 5: Based upon this amazing story of change, what can we expect from God when it comes to unsaved friends, family members, colleagues and neighbours?

- **THE WOMAN WHO WAS BOUND BY THE SPIRIT OF INFIRMITY** (*Ask a cell member to read Luke 13:11-13*)

QUESTION 6: What can our expectation be toward God when it comes to healing? Is God still able to heal suddenly?

I don't care how long you have had the same problem in your life! The Lord whom you seek... will come suddenly and deliver you from that depression, ailment, condition, weakness.

- **PAUL AND SILAS IN PRISON** (*Ask a cell member to read Acts 16:25-26*)

QUESTION 7: What does this story of Paul and Silas tell us about God's ability to save us from unfavorable circumstances and situations?

- **PETER WHO TOILED ALL NIGHT AND CAUGHT NOTHING** (*Ask a cell member to read Luke 5:4-6*)

QUESTION 8: In this story Jesus changed Peter's business situation in a moment. What is your expectation from God when it comes to your business, career and finances?
