MEDITATE ON THESE THINGS PART 1

10 SEPTEMBER 2023

WELCOME

Welcome all members who are joining the Homecell whether online or physical.
If HC is on Zoom only - do an Icebreaker on WhatsApp ± 15 minutes before Zoom cell.
If HC is physical – do an Icebreaker for approx. 10 minutes at start of HC.

WORSHIP

If HC is physical -1 Praise & 2 Worship. This will create the right atmosphere for your time together. End Worship 2 in prayer.
If ZOOM only - Challenge cell members to spend a few minutes in Worship before your ZOOM/Online Homecell starts.

WORD

“Whatever things are true”

Philippians 4:8 NKJV

Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things are noble, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue and if there is anything praiseworthy- meditate on these things.

Ask a homecell member to read Philippians 4:6-6 NKJV

Q: What is the truth of the Gospel?

- The truth of the Gospel will always speak to your Christ identity.
- It will challenge you to set your mind on where you are seated in Christ.
- It will challenge you to meditate, think and pray on what God says about you and not what religion or the enemy will say about you.
- The truth you meditate on will determine what you believe and speak and see about yourself and your future.

Ask a homecell member to read Romans 2:12-16 NKJV and Colossians 1:28-29 TPT

Q: What is the message that we as a homecell must take into the world?

- As a homecell and children of God we are chosen and commissioned to take the Gospel to the world in victory and purpose.
- The Gospel is a solution message and not a problem message.
- Sin is the problem. God's Son is the solution.
- As Christians we must not remind the world of their sin, but we need to lead them to the solution and truth of Christ.

Ask a homecell member to read Genesis 1:26 KJVS

Q: What does this scripture verse says about your image?

- I am not born with a self-image but a God image.
- I was born to have dominion over the earth.

Ask a homecell member to read 1 Corinthians 15:10 KJVS

Q: What do we learn about the Grace of God?

- By His Grace, you are who you are.
- There is something special that you have been blessed with that no one else has.
- God's Grace is with me always.
- There is a Grace for your race that you need to embrace and not try and replace.
- My hand is unique and anointed by God.
- Heaven is a wealthy place from where God wants to pour these riches out on you.

Ask a few homecell members to read Philippians 3:13-15, 4-7 and 4:13 KJV

Q: What do these verses teach us about our past and our future?

- I must let go of the past lies and exchange those lies for God's truth.
- I must reach for the things which are before me.
- I must rejoice in the Lord daily.
- I must in everything by prayer and supplication give thanks to God and with thanksgiving let my requests be made known unto God.
- The peace of God shall keep my heart and mind through Christ Jesus.
- I can do all things through Christ which strengthens me.

WORKS

1. **PRAYER** - Take time to pray for (1) lost & prodigals on your prayer or target lists (2) One another (lay hands 1-1 or groups of 2-3)
2. **CARE** - As a HC, identify urgent needs (among people in your immediate world) - food needs, people who are staying alone, marriage challenges, financial needs, business, career, employment needs, emotional needs etc.). How can we meet those needs?
3. **DISCIPLESHIP** - Equip HC in Basic Doctrine (Water Baptism, Tongues, Serving, Giving, Honour, Vision)
4. **EVANGELISM** - Equip HC in reaching their world (Build relationship with Oikos, Identify Man of Peace, Share Your Verbal Witness, Invite to Church & HC)
