## **THE GOSPEL ACTIVATES GENEROSITY (PART 1)**

**26 NOVEMBER 2023**

### **WELCOME**

Welcome all members who are joining the Homecell whether online or physical.  
If HC is on Zoom only - do an Icebreaker on WhatsApp ± 15 minutes before Zoom cell.  
If HC is physical – do an Icebreaker for approx. 10 minutes at start of HC.

### **WORSHIP**

If HC is physical -1 Praise & 2 Worship. This will create the right atmosphere for your time together. End Worship 2 in prayer.  
If ZOOM only - Challenge cell members to spend a few minutes in Worship before your ZOOM/Online Homecell starts.

### **WORD**

**Ask a homecell member to read John 3:16 and John 1:14**

**Q: What do we learn from God through these scriptures?**

- That God is a giving God.
- He loved us so much that He gave His only Son.
- The Word became fleshly and moved onto the earth.
- Our God is also a generous God.

**Ask a homecell member to read John 3:20 NLT**

**Q: What changes when we hear the Gospel?**

- The Gospel and God can do so much more than what we expect.
- The Gospel will change you.
- The Gospel activates generosity.
- The Gospel gives a desire to want to do more for God and yourself.
- The Gospel breaks barriers.

**Ask a homecell member to read Galatians 3:7-8 NKJV**

- The Gospel was preached to Abraham in the Old Testament.
- What Jesus was going to do was foreseen.

**1. And the scripture foreseeing that God would – Jeremiah 29:11 NLT**

- The word of God must go ahead of us.
- God knows what will happen in your life.
- God has not changed His mind or plans about your life.

## **2. Preached the Gospel to Abraham**

### **3. In you all the nations shall be blessed**

- As a result of having the Gospel preached to Abraham, nations were going to be blessed.
- The Gospel message is a nation blessing message.
- The church of Jesus that preaches the Gospel is a nation blessing church.

### **Ask a homecell member to read Genesis 14:18-20**

#### **4. Notice that Melchizedek brings bread and wine.**

- Bread and wine speak of God's covenant blessing with everyone who is a child of God.
- Do it often in remembrance of my covenant promise and blessing.

#### **5. Melchizedek blessed Abram.**

- In Christ you are blessed and not cursed.
- You cannot be cursed by Christ – Galatians 3:10-14

#### **6. And blessed be God Most High, who has defeated your enemies for you.**

- God is fighting for us not with us.
- We labour and walk in faith from victory not for victory.

#### **7. Then Abram gave Melchizedek a tenth of all the goods he had recovered.**

- The Gospel activates generosity.

#### **8. Most Christians don't understand the curse the Gospel breaks over lives of those who are in Christ.**

- In the Gospels Jesus was removing the barriers of the curse until He would become the curse of humanity so that humanity could walk in freedom.
- The Gospel is a Son focused message of curse destruction.

***Your inward treasure will be a direct reflection of your outer actions!***

## **WORKS**

- 1. PRAYER** - Take time to pray for (1) lost & prodigals on your prayer or target lists (2) One another (lay hands 1-1 or groups of 2-3)
- 2. CARE** - As a HC, identify urgent needs (among people in your immediate world) - food needs, people who are staying alone, marriage challenges, financial needs, business, career, employment needs, emotional needs etc.). How can we meet those needs?
- 3. DISCIPLESHIP** - Equip HC in Basic Doctrine (Water Baptism, Tongues, Serving, Giving, Honour, Vision)
- 4. EVANGELISM** - Equip HC in reaching their world (Build relationship with Oikos, Identify Man of Peace, Share Your Verbal Witness, Invite to Church & HC)
