WELCOME

Welcome all members who are joining the Homecell whether online or physical.

WORSHIP

WORD

Luke 19:9 NKJV

“And Jesus said to him, Today salvation has come to this house.”
.”

Q: How do we relate to this statement that the miracle of salvation coming to the house of Zacchaeus?

- Zacchaeus represents us all in some way before we knew Christ.
- We all were corrupt, proud, seeking for riches, seeking for position in society and acceptance from man yet knowing that the peace we longed and sought after in the wrong places never brought true and lasting peace.

Q: What is the meaning of the word house in Greek and what does it speak of?

- House in Greek means Oikos
- It speaks of a dwelling:
 - A family
 - A home
 - A temple
 - A building (the house of God, a tabernacle)
 - An inhabited place, the place where one has fixed his residence.

The miracle that God seeks to give is found in different kinds of houses.

1. The house of God

Ask a homecell member to read Psalm 122:1 AMP

Q: Were you glad when they said “Let us go to the house of the Lord CRC Cape Town?”

- We know God is not found any longer in buildings made with human hands, but the people that come to the house of God.
- The people that come to the house of God is known as the household of faith.

2. The household of faith

Ask a homecell member to read Galatians 6:10 AMP

Q: What does the household of faith mean to you?

- When you plant yourself into a house of God you become part of the household of faith.
- You are then positioned for a miracle in and amongst the household.
- The household of faith allow us to do good to all people.

3. Your physical house

Ask a homecell member to read Mark 5:39-42 ERV, 14:3 and 10:38:42

Q: These scripture verses speak about miracles in the house, can you identify them?

- We all have a right to stand on the word of God.
- There is healing in the house.
- There is gratitude in the house.
- There is rest in the house.
- We receive provision and have fellowship in the house

4. Spiritual house

Ask a homecell member to read 1 Peter 2:5-8 AMP and Matthew 7:24-27 TPT

Q: What does it mean when God enters the boundaries of your life?

- He gives us a new heart and a new Spirit.
- He begins a good work in you and will complete it.
- We then carry the Spirit of God in us.

This week let's bring the fragrance of the anointing of Jesus Christ to the world!

WORKS

1. **PRAYER** - Take time to pray for (1) lost & prodigals on your prayer or target lists (2) One another (lay hands 1-1 or groups of 2-3)
2. **CARE** - As a HC, identify urgent needs (among people in your immediate world) - food needs, people who are staying alone, marriage challenges, financial needs, business, career, employment needs, emotional needs etc.). How can we meet those needs?
3. **DISCIPLESHIP** - Equip HC in Basic Doctrine (Water Baptism, Tongues, Serving, Giving, Honour, Vision)

4. **EVANGELISM** - Equip HC in reaching their world (Build relationship with Oikos, Identify Man of Peace, Share Your Verbal Witness, Invite to Church & HC)
