BUILDING YOURSELVES UP (PART 2)

WELCOME

Welcome all members who are joining the Homecell whether online or physical.
If HC is on Zoom only - do an Icebreaker on WhatsApp ± 15 minutes before Zoom cell.
If HC is physical – do an Icebreaker for approx. 10 minutes at start of HC.

WORSHIP

If HC is physical -1 Praise & 2 Worship. This will create the right atmosphere for your time together. End Worship 2 in prayer.

If ZOOM only - Challenge cell members to spend a few minutes in Worship before your ZOOM/Online Homecell starts.

WORD

Jude 1:20-23 NKJV

“But you, beloved, building yourselves up on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Spirit, [21] keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life. [22] And on some have compassion, making a distinction; [23] but others save with fear, pulling them out of the fire, hating even the garment defiled by the flesh.”

Last week we saw that the foundation you lay before you build anything especially a building determines everything:

A building's foundation:

1. Holds up the building.
2. Enables the building to survive storms.
3. Keeps moisture or damp rising.
4. Keeps insects and rot out.
5. Determines the height the building can rise to.

The stability, the safety, the integrity, the value and the purpose of what you can do in or with the building are all totally dependent upon the foundation.

Ask a few homecell members to read 1 Peter 2:5a, Matthew 16:18, 1 Corinthians 3:9, 2 Corinthians 6:1

Q: According to these verses, who does the building once the foundation has been laid?

God builds together with us! God builds, but not in separation.

Many think the responsibility lies on us entirely after salvation. Although there most definitely is a responsibility from our side to build, we don't build separate from God with self-generated effort. Rather, we build on top of the foundation with the power and faith and righteousness and holiness and anointing received from the foundation.

We build on top of the foundation not next to or separate from Him.

Ask a homecell member to read Romans 8:38-39

Nothing can separate us from Jesus, our Foundation.

Ask a few homecell members to read Colossians 1:28-29 TPT and Philippians 3:14

Q: If Christ is our message, in what direction should our lives be going?

Proverbs 15:24 tells us that, "the way of life winds upward for the wise". If Christ is our message, our lives should be going upward not downward!

- Build your business up on your Christ foundation, not separate from.
- Build your marriage up on your Christ foundation, not separate from.
- Build your spiritual life up on your Christ foundation, not separate from.

Ask a homecell member to read Jude 1:20-21a

Q: According to Jude, what do we use to build ourselves up?

- Faith
- Prayer
- Love
- Mercy

Understand that all of these building blocks stem from and are first in the foundation before they are ours.

WORKS

1. **PRAYER** - Take time to pray for (1) lost & prodigals on your prayer or target lists (2) One another (lay hands 1-1 or groups of 2-3)
2. **CARE** - As a HC, identify urgent needs (among people in your immediate world) - food needs, people who are staying alone, marriage challenges, financial needs, business, career, employment needs, emotional needs etc.). How can we meet those needs?
3. **DISCIPLESHIP** - Equip HC in Basic Doctrine (Water Baptism, Tongues, Serving, Giving, Honour, Vision)
4. **EVANGELISM** - Equip HC in reaching their world (Build relationship with Oikos, Identify Man of Peace, Share Your Verbal Witness, Invite to Church & HC)
