PREPARING FOR MULTIPLICATION 2025 (PART 2)

20 NOVEMBER 2024

WELCOME

Welcome all members who are joining the Homecell whether online or physical.
If HC is on Zoom only - do an Icebreaker on WhatsApp ± 15 minutes before Zoom cell.
If HC is physical – do an Icebreaker for approx. 10 minutes at start of HC.

WORSHIP

If HC is physical -1 Praise & 2 Worship. This will create the right atmosphere for your time together. End Worship 2 in prayer.
If ZOOM only - Challenge cell members to spend a few minutes in Worship before your ZOOM/ Online Homecell starts.

WORD

Genesis 1:28 NKJV

Then God blessed them, and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth."

Ask HC members to read Gen 1: 28 NKJV and Gen 9:1 AMP

Q: In these verses, God commands Adam and Noah to "BE"(identity). What do you understand by multiplication as compared to dominion

- Multiplication is not the end.
- Multiplication is a step in the process to Dominion.
- At Salvation, He is the vine and we become the branches.
- We are good trees because we are connected to the vine.
- A good tree cannot bear bad fruit.
- We are therefore fruitful (display the fruit of the Spirit).
- Our fruit thereafter bears more trees (multiplication) to become an orchard.
- A man with many orchards is a man of influence.
- That is, he has dominion.

Ask a HC member to read Gen 13:15 - 17 TPT and Galatians 3:14 TPT.

Q: According to these verses, how do you receive the covenant of multiplication?

- This covenant of multiplication is transferred to us through faith in Jesus.
- As a believer you have a multiplication covenant promise which is your kingdom right.
- Jesus reminds us that we must not allow the enemy to fool us into thinking anything other than what is our sonship right.

Ask members to read John 10:10, John 3:30 and 1 Corinthians 15:30-31 CEV
What do you understand by dying to self?

- As Believer's we do not need to die to self.
- Our old nature has died at Salvation.
- We are now alive in Christ.

Ask HC members to read Ephesians 2: 5-6 NKJV and Philippians 3:14 CEB.
Q: What are the keys to dominion as a Believer?

- Staying connected to Christ.
- - He is the vine.
- Acting as God's representative.
- - Bearing good fruit
- Being led by the Holy Spirit.
- - leading us to multiplication and then dominion.
- To know that we are seated with Christ in heavenly places.

Ask a HC member to read 2 Corinthians 9:10 NKJV.

Q: God does not multiply known need, God multiplies sown seed. What do you understand by this statement.

- For something to grow, there must be seed.
- God had the need for redemption for man's sin (the need)
- For redemption to grow, God planted a seed.
- God sowed His son. (The seed)
- A seed has to die to bear fruit. (Jesus died on the cross)
- That met the need of redemption.
- As oxygen is to breathing and water is to fish; so is seed to soil.
- The seed meets the need.

WORKS

1. **PRAYER** - Take time to pray for (1) lost & prodigals on your prayer or target lists (2) One another (lay hands 1-1 or groups of 2-3)
2. **CARE** - As a HC, identify urgent needs (among people in your immediate world) - food needs, people who are staying alone, marriage challenges, financial needs, business, career, employment needs, emotional needs etc.). How can we meet those needs?
3. **DISCIPLESHIP** - Equip HC in Basic Doctrine (Water Baptism, Tongues, Serving, Giving, Honour, Vision)
4. **EVANGELISM** - Equip HC in reaching their world (Build relationship with Oikos, Identify Man of Peace, Share Your Verbal Witness, Invite to Church & HC)
