AN INVASION OF GOD'S GUIDANCE (PART 4)

WELCOME

Welcome all members who are joining the Homecell!

WORSHIP

Please set up 1 praise song and 1 worship song. End Worship in prayer.

WORD

Start by asking members who would like to share, what stood out for them from this week Sunday's sermon?

Ask a homecell member to read:

John 16:13

"However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come."

Q 1: What does it look like in everyday life to rely on the Holy Spirit as your Guide rather than relying on your own understanding?

- **The Holy Spirit leads us into truth step-by-step**, showing us the *right* way before revealing the *truth* and then helping us live the *life*.
- **We no longer say "I don't know" hopelessly**, because every believer has a permanent Guide who speaks, teaches, and reveals what we need.
- **Depending on Him protects us from paths that "seem right" but end in frustration**, because He redirects us into God's intended way.

Ask a homecell member to read:

JOHN 14:6

"Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.""

Q 2: Jesus gives a three-step pattern—Way, Truth, Life. How does this pattern help you understand God's guidance more practically?

- **God always starts with "the way"**—the direction, prompting, or step He wants you to take first.
- **Once you obey the way, He reveals truth**, bringing clarity, understanding, and peace as you walk.
- **Then you experience life**, meaning fruitfulness, effectiveness, and living in God's fullness rather than frustration.

Ask a homecell member to read:

ROMANS 8:14

"For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God."

Q 3: How does spiritual maturity grow when we allow ourselves to be led by the Spirit?

- **We learn to recognize His voice more clearly**, rather than reacting from emotion, pressure, or assumptions.
- **We become confident in decision-making**, knowing that God is actively guiding, not leaving us to guess.
- **We step into sonship identity**, living as people who are guided, not driven—rooted, not confused—secure, not anxious.

Ask a homecell member to read:

LUKE 24:13-32

"Were not our hearts burning within us... as He opened the Scriptures to us?"

Q 4: Why do you think the disciples couldn't recognize Jesus on the way, and how does this speak to moments when we feel confused or frustrated?

- **Their eyes weren't yet spiritually opened**, illustrating how believers can walk with Jesus yet miss His guidance without revelation.
- **Confusion came from focusing on circumstances**, not on what God had already spoken through Scripture and prophecy.
- **Clarity came when Jesus opened the Word**, showing that guidance becomes clear when Scripture is illuminated by the Spirit.

Ask a homecell member to read:

PROVERBS 16:25

"There is a way which seems right to a man and appears straight before him, but its end is the way of death."

Q 5: What does this verse teach us about trusting our instincts versus seeking God's direction first?

- **Our natural instincts can mislead us**, even when they feel right or logical.
- **The Holy Spirit reveals God's better way**, helping us avoid decisions that bring regret, delay, or frustration.
- **Walking in God's way leads us toward life**, purpose, peace, and alignment with His will rather than self-driven outcomes.

CHALLENGE/REFLECTION:

Throughout this week, pause before making decisions—big or small—and simply pray: **"Holy Spirit, show me the way."**

Then take a moment to be still.

- Notice the gentle nudges
- Pay attention to Scripture that comes to mind
- Reflect on where peace settles inside you

Ask yourself: **Where have I been moving in my own "seems right" path and where is God trying to guide me into His way, His truth, and His life?**

Choose one practical area this week (work, relationships, finances, time, serving) and intentionally follow the Holy Spirit's leading.

He is not distant. He is your Guide—always speaking, always leading, always present.

WORKS

SOUL WINNING

In this final section, we turn the Word into action by asking how the Holy Spirit is leading us—not only in our daily decisions, but toward the people who need to encounter Jesus through us this week.

Ask a homecell member to read:

ACTS 1:8

“But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me...”

Q: How can we stay sensitive to the Holy Spirit’s leading in our everyday interactions so that we can boldly and lovingly share Jesus with the people He places on our path this week?

- **Ask daily:** “*Holy Spirit, who are You leading me to today?*”
- **Stay attentive to His nudges** — the person who seems open, discouraged, or simply in need of a kind word.
- **Step out in bold, gentle obedience:** share a testimony, offer prayer, start a hopeful conversation, or invite someone to Homecell or church.
- **Rely on the Spirit’s power**, trusting that the same Holy Spirit who guides you also empowers you to witness for Jesus.

Remember: **The Spirit leads us into truth — and truth always points to Jesus.**

When we follow His guidance, He not only leads us, He leads us to people who need Him.

This week, trust that the same Spirit guiding your steps is also guiding you to someone ready for hope, love, and truth.
