WORD

Q: What stood out for you about Sunday's sermon? What are some of the names of God that you can recall?

A: Allow members to share. Jehovah El Elyon, Jehovah El Roi, Jehovah El Shaddai, Jehovah El Olam, Jehovah Jerih, Jehovah Rapha, Jehovah Nissi, Jehovah Maccadeshem, Jehovah Shalom, Jehovah Raah, Jehovah Tsidkenu

Ask homecell members to read: Ecclesiastics 1 verse 9 AMP, Exodus 3 verse 13-15 AMP

Q: Ps Aidan spoke about fear and mysticism that people keep using to bring about fear. What do these scriptures teach us?

A: Every generation has their own challenges that they will face. However, we read that there is nothing new under the sun. If God could assist generations before our generation, why would he not assist you. Exodus clearly states in the latter part of verse 15, "This is My Name forever and this is My memorial to all generations."

Ask a homecell member to read: Numbers 23 verse 19 AMP, Malachi 3 verse 6 NKJV, Hebrews 6 verse 6-16, 19 TPT

Q: What assurance do we get out of these scriptures as to who God is? Get 1 or 2 members to share a testimony of how the promises of God brought them through a difficult time.

A: The Bible says that our hope and our faith is in God and his promises are like an unbreakable anchor.

Ask a homecell member to read: Philippians 1 verse 66 NKJV, Hebrews 6 verse 16-18 TPT

Q: We all face setbacks and discouragements at times, how important are scriptures like these during our journey?

A: We don't need to worry or panic about finishing, we need to believe and trust God's promises and yield to the Spirit of God leading us in the way that we should go.

Ask a homecell member to read: Genesis 14 verse 18-20 NKJV



Q: What situation are you facing today? Where you might be saying “God where are you in my life? God are you hearing my prayers?

A: In this portion of scripture Abraham found himself in a difficult spot and God revealed Himself to him as Jehovah El Elyon- God Most High. Abraham's response to God's assurance of who He is, was generosity

Ask a homecell members to read the name of God and the scripture verse, you can ask them as well to share a short testimony on that for them.
