WELCOME

WORSHIP

WORD

Q: What stood out for you about Sunday's sermon? What are some of the names of God that you can recall?

A: Allow members to share. Jehovah El Elyon, Jehovah El Roi, Jehovah El Shaddai, Jehovah El Olam, Jehovah Jerih, Jehovah Rapha, Jehovah Nissi, Jehovah Maccadeshem, Jehovah Shalom, Jehovah Raah, Jehovah Tsidkenu

Ask homecell members to read: John 4:23-24 KJV

Q: When Jesus says that God is Spirit and that true worshippers must worship Him in spirit and in truth, what does that teach us about our relationship with God?

A: This teaches us that God is not limited to a physical place, a building, a religious routine, or an outward performance. In John 4, the Samaritan woman thought worship depended on the correct mountain or temple, but Jesus showed her that a new time had come where worship would be from the heart, by the Spirit, and according to truth.

Ask a homecell member to read: Acts 2:1-4 NKJV

Q: Why is Pentecost more than just a dramatic spiritual event?



A: Pentecost was the fulfilment of God's promise to pour out His Spirit on all flesh. It was not simply a loud, dramatic, or emotional moment. It was God announcing that His Spirit had come to dwell in His people. Ps Aidan said that in the Old Covenant, God often spoke externally through angels, prophets, signs, or writing on walls. But in the New Covenant, God speaks to us internally by His Spirit.

Ask a homecell member to read: John 14:26 AMPC

Q: Why is it important to understand that the Holy Spirit helps us know Jesus and the Father's love better?

A: Jesus came to reveal the Father, and the Holy Spirit continues that work inside us. Many people have wrong ideas about God. They may see Him as angry, distant, disappointed, harsh, or difficult to please. But the Holy Spirit teaches us who God really is. Ps Aidan said that if we encounter the Holy Spirit, we should know the love of God better afterwards. The Spirit does not lead us away from Jesus. He leads us deeper into Jesus.

Ask a homecell member to read: Acts 1:8 KJV

Q: According to Acts 1:8, what is the purpose of the power we receive from the Holy Spirit?

A: The power of the Holy Spirit is not given so that we can show off, become spiritually superior, or draw attention to ourselves. The verse says we receive power to be witnesses of Jesus. Ps Aidan said that we are vessels or conduits. The power belongs to God, not to us. When God works through us, we do not become the focus. Jesus remains the focus. A witness tells what they have seen, heard, and experienced. This means our testimony matters, but it should always lead people to Jesus. We can share what God has done in our lives, but the goal is to point people to the One who transformed us.

Ask a homecell member to read: Romans 8:16 AMPC; John 16:8 AMPC

Q: How does the Holy Spirit help us in everyday situations like parenting, work, family pressure, decision-making, and moments where we do not know what to do?

A: The Holy Spirit is not only for church services. He is practical. He helps us when we do not know what to pray, what decision to make, how to respond, or how to keep going. Ps Aidan gave practical examples of parenting, raising children, running a business, dealing with staff, facing pressure, and making decisions. These are ordinary parts of life, but we need the help of the Holy Spirit in them. The Spirit gives wisdom, discernment, peace, patience, and strength. He helps us live differently from the world, not by pretending life is easy, but by giving us God's help in the middle of real life.



CALL TO ACTION:
